Mr. Bornschein came to this office at 3:30 p.m. this afternoon, and presented me with his letter of resignation as committeeman of Troop 15 of Bellaire, Michigan. The information stated in the letter has been verbally confirmed by the Pastor of the Chartered Partner, who is also committee chairman, and has been involved in this whole matter. This man is knowledgeable about the procedures of the Boy Scouts of America, and knows that the Registration Service has his name on file.

During the interview, in which he presented his resignation letter, he indicated that he hoped that his condition, as outlined in the letter, would at some time in the future be cured. As he said in the letter of resignation, he may attempt to register with the Boy Scouts of America at that time. If such time does occur, I will request direct guidance from you.

We will refund his \$5 registration fee, and send it to him by check.

Dear Paul,

I regret to inform you that due to several medical conditions which are beyond my control I am forced to offer you my resignation.

I have severe reactive hypoglycemia with an associated cronic brain dysfunction which is centered in the left temporal labe of my brain. Both of these conditions are under treatment and both are curable. The hypoglycemia is controlled by a strict diet. The seizure activity is controlled with anticonvulsant medications and will eventually disappear, hopefully within the next three to four months. Once this type of seizure activity is gone it does not reoccur.

Both of these diseases have very serious side effects as they both effect the function of the brain. The brain relies on a constant supply of glucose to meet it's energy requirements. During a hypoglycemic attack the body releases a hormone called insulin in excess. This excess amount of insulin depletes the circulating glucose and the brain starves. The seizure activity is simpler to a short circuit in a computer, the machine is malfunctioning and will not give the correct response. These conditions are associated with a wide range of symptoms including tremor, headache, loss of impulse and behavioral control, delusion, fatigue, loss of memory, abrupt changes in personality, come and death to name but a few. As you can see, note of these symptoms can contribute to the well being of the patient.

When in the future I am again able to function at my normal high level of enthusiasim, I may request reinstatement.

Pleads guilty

24-year-old Kearney Township man pleaded guilty Friday to a fourth degree criminal sexual conduct

Joseph John Bornschein III was charged with committing a sex offence involving a minor Nov. 6, 1961 at the Bornschein home.

Investigation into the incident began Nov. 13, and Bornschein was arrested Nov. 19, according to Antrim County Prosecuting Attorney James Young.

Court proceedings in the case were delayed at the request of the defense, Young said. "Given the seriousness of the charge, the defense requested and was granted by the court, delays for certain medical research on the case."

Bornschein made his plea before Circuit Court Judge William R. Brown. Judge Brown released him on a personal recognizance bond, pending a pre-sentence investivation.

Sentencing will be held in Circuit Court in approximately 30 days.
