Dear Paul:

I am attaching a letter received from a mother of one of our Scouts concerning the Scoutmaster of our Troop #18, Mr. Bob Deal.

I have talked the matter over with both the Scout and mother and the Scout sticks to his story.

We have asked Mr. Deal to disassociate himself from Scouting due to this complaint. He denies the charge but admits to sleeping in the tent with boys on a regular basis in connection with Troop outings.

Apparently, Mr. Deal has contacted a lawyer and he has contacted our former Council legal advisor. We have not heard from the lawyer.

Mr. Deal informed at least one of his Troop Committeemen of the charge and that individual has contacted me. He feels that the Scout is in error. I have explained to him procedure for appeal as stated in your guidelines. I doubt, however, that we'll hear anymore about the case.

Please advise if further action is required on my part.

Dear Mr. Malphrus,

On March 14th, 1982, while on his first weekend camping trip, our son, (age 11) awoke during the early morning hours with Mr. Bob Deal Taying beside him. He was aware of his levi-shorts and underwear being pulled down and his genitals fondled. He was afraid to say anything or even keep his eyes open. Mr. Deal said nothing. It tried to fold his arms over the waistline of his pants to keep this episode from continuing and was unsuccessful. Two older scouts were asleep nearby in the same tent, but no other boys Todd's age. The had slept the previous night in another tent.

informed his Grandmother on arriving home what had occurred, as his parents were out of town for the day. She discussed the event with his Aunt and Uncle, and they talked to also. All informed the parents when they arrived. After talking to an attorney and our family doctor, it was decided to notify the Scouts Association to handle the situation with the upmost discretion.

We feel that Mr. Bob Deal should not be allowed to work with boys at this age and continue to represent the Boy Scouts of America. We feel that he has a very serious problem and needs professional couseling. We hope that this complaint will be met with serious regard. We are aware that Scoutmasters are volunteers and that this is a most awkward situation. However, we feel you should be made aware of this matter.

Mr. Deal also talked to Mrs. on Thursday before this occurrence and he asked her if was a light or hard sleeper. Mr. felt this most unusual as he was never asked this with his past experience in working with the Scouts.

Thank you for your regard in this particular matter.
