It should be noted that Mr. Dow has been extremely active during and before the writers service with the Green Mountain Council. We have had numerous allegations of misbehavior on his part but until the case which is described in the news article we have been unable to get facts to warrant this action. The writer has discussed accusations with Dow on a number of occasions during the past ten years and feel strongly that for the reasons documented, and reasons of his personal judgement he should not be registered in the Boy Scouts of America.

It should be noted that he has been requested for several years to be a member of the Aquatic Staff for National Jamborees.

Former S.B. Boy Scout Leader Pleads Innocent to Lewdness

Cariton Dow, 32, a former I South Burlington Boy Scout lend-Ver, pleaded innocent Friday to beyd and lascivious conduct with a child.

Dow is accused of fonding a 12-year-old member of Troop 23 to at his Williston Road home in April or May 1980.

Chittenden County State's Attorney Mark Reller said Dow, 7038; not charged in a second care of alleged level behavior with a Boy Scout because the incident took place on a camping trip outside the state.

A South Burlington police inrestigation concluded in November, Dow was dropped as a scout leader in the late fall or serly winter, according to Richard Bockes, executive director of the Green Mountain Council of the Boy Scouts.

Dow appeared in Vermont District Court in Burlington and was released without ball.

According to an affidavit filed by South Burlington police, Dow Invited the 12-year-old and his brother to spend the night of his bone before a Boy Scout outing.

The youth told police Dow put the brothers in separate trions, then began to fondle him.

"(The victim) also solvised that he was too scared to answer Dow or to make any effort to word off this incident due to Dow's violent; temper," the affidavit said.

The affidavit said the two alleged victims later talked of their problems with Dow and decided to report the alleged incidents to their parents.
