Enclosed is a personal and confidential information sheet on Karl H. Kittsteiner, per your request.

Our records indicate that Kittsteiner was charged with molesting a 9-year old boy and, at that time, was housed in the Wayne County jail. We never really received any final disposition of this case.

We worked with the chartered organization, unit leadership, and the State Police during the early part of the investigations and found no evidence that there were any other incidents involving boys in Scouting.

I hope this information will be sufficient for you to make an adequate decision. Please inform us of your decision so we may act accordingly here in Detroit.



INTERVIEW

The victim was interviewed at his residence in the presence of his parents on this date. The child was found to be more comfortable in his ability to relate what transpired on the night he slept at the KITTSTEINER residence. He related the following: As stated previously, he spent the day with the KITTSTEINER's, got home late and went to bed. _____advised he was in the top bunk, with KARL Jr. in the bottom bunk. Victim advised he was awakened by the suspect and carried to the couch. Clad in his pajamas, and KITTSTEINER dressed, the suspect touched was lying on his back. After a short his stomach and his "privates" while time, KITTSTEINER took him into the suspect's bedroom. During this time, the suspect was seen clad only in his undershorts. The victim advised that he and the suspect were in bed when the suspect took his a and told the victim to rub his "butt", and the victim complied. The victim further advised that the suspect moved on his side and exposed his penis (described as private parts by the victim). He instructed the victim to rub his penis and _____advised he complied with the suspect'. instructions. Victim advised there was other physical contact between he and the suspect but could not recall what it was.

USE OF ROUGH DRAWING:

During the interview when the victim advised he was lying on the couch and the suspect touched him in his "private parts," the interview stopped momentarily and a rough drawing was shown to the victim. This handwritten outline of a human being was shown, and the victim asked to draw an "x" where he was touched. The victim drew an "x" in the crotch area and an "x" on the stomach area of the drawing.

When the victim alluded to the activities in the suspect's bedroom, three rough drawings were made. The first depicting the victim in bed. Advised he was directed to rub the suspect's buttocks with his hand. The victim drew an "x" on the right hand. The two additional drawings represented to the victim the suspect. When asked where the suspect put his hand and one drawing depicting the suspect on his side/stomach, the victim drew an "x" on the buttocks. On the second rough drawing depicting the suspect on his back, the victim drew an "x" on the crotch area. The victim advised that his hand was placed on the suspect's penis by the suspect. 

On 2-15-82, KARL KITTSTEINER writes he has had no further luck with and that KITTSTEINER feels gets sick every time he, KITTSTEINER, makes advances. That it's a sticky situation being that father is a lawyer.

On 2-24-82, he wrote a letter indicating he got some good feels in with some of his cub scouts, and hopes to make headway with

On 3-1-82, Michigan State Police Officers received a note from KITTSTEINUR requesting our assistance in finding "chicken", a term known as children for sexual relationship.

D/Sqt. MATTIOLI had six undercover meetings with EARI KITTSTEINER. On all occasions, he asked for help in finding boys. He also repeated his sexual encounters with the cub scout.

On 6-2-82, a search warrant was executed in that a conversation between KITTSTEINER and D/Sgt. MATTIOLI was to be recorded. KITTSTEINER alluded to several sexual encounters he has had with various children. Also offered suggestions on how to secure children for sex. In this recorded statement, KITTSTEINER advised that during the winter from cub scouts spent the night and advised he got the boy to cry and, "could of gotten in trouble over that one."

On 10-15-82, D/Sgt. MATTIOLI interviewed

The bou advised that nearly every time he went to cub scouts, KARL KITTSTEINER would hug and sit him on his lap. On the night he, slept over, he remembers the suspect waking him up and being carried into the front room. Some tupe of argument ensued and ecame upset as to why he, KARL KITTSTEINER, was touching him or why KARL wanted him to touch Hr. KARL KITTSTEINER, further advised that many times during the day KITTSTEINER told that he owed him a favor but would not specify what it was. During the encounter in the living room, KITTSTEINER told that it has buring the favor you owe me for being your den leader. Advised that KITTSTEINER did touch him and what he did was very wrong. Further advised that the hugging and fondling and the walks to another room where some hugging took place was a common occurance throughout the cub scout year by KITTSTEINER.

summarized in saying that KITTSTEINER did in fact hun and touch him and that their argument was over the fact that KITTSTEINER was touching him where he shouldn't. KITTSTEINER instructed the youth not to tell anyone about what happened and that still owed him a favor. concluded his statement by advising that one time KITTSTEINER picked him up, carried him into a back room, and started "playing" with him and acting weird and he had to slip out of his grip to escape.

Sexual activities with the boy are discussed in detail in letters written by KITTSTEINER to Inspector GROZA, U.S. Postal, using the alias of "TODD". Undercover meetings with KITTSTEINER corroborated what he wrote in the letters and that he was writing to "TODD." A search warrant revealed an admission of contact he had with

The letters and meetings with KITTSTEINER revealed his desire for investigators to get children for him. The interview of revealed that KITTSTEIN as stated in his letters and conversations, was very fond of the child. KITTSTEINER, according to the boy, hugged and played with him every time they were together. On the night he slept over, remembers being touched by KITTSTEINER, heing asked to touch the suspect, and becoming upset and shaken as to what was happening. He remembers being told that he owes the suspect a favor and was instructed not to tell anyone what happened this night. advised that since the contact with KITTSTEINER, he has dreaded returning and sometimes would be sick so he wouldn't have to attend meetings.
