Man Faces Charges In Two Sex Incidents

A 39-year-old Wyoming man has been charged with two counts of criminal sexual conduct for separate incidents at two Kent County drive-in theaters.

Roger William Robach, of 3655 Collingwood St. SW, waived examination on one charge of fourth degree criminal sexual conduct for a July 28 Incident at the Cascade Drive-In Theater. Robach was arraigned on the charge (Aug. 5 by 83rd District Court Magistrate Gerard Shouse,

Robach, waived preliminary hearing and entered a plea of innocent to the charge, which carries a maximum penalty of two years.

According to the complaint, Ros buch used force or coercion to pefform the alleged act with a male.


Dear Dick:
