### Man Faces Charges In Two Sex Incidents

A 39-year-old Wyoming man has been charged with two counts of criminal sexual conduct for separate incidents at two Kent County drive-in theaters.

247 Roger William Robach, of 3655 Collingwood St. SW, waived examination on one charge of fourth degree criminal sexual conduct for a July 28 incident at the Cascade Drive-In Theater. Robach was arraigned on the charge (Aug. 5) by 63rd District Court Magistrate Gerard Shouse.

Robach waived preliminary hearing and entered a plea of innocent to the charge, which carries a

maximum penalty of two years.

According to the complaint, Robach used force or coercion to perform the alleged act with a male.

Robach was arraigned on the second charge Tuesday before 63rd District Judge Joseph B. White.

He pleaded not guilty to the charge of second degree criminal sexual conduct for sexually assaulting a boy under the age of 13 at the Plainfield Drive-In Theater July 16.

Robach was released on his own recognizance on both counts, and currently is awaiting trial on the charges in Kent County Circuit Court.


Sorry for the delay but securing anything in documentation form is not easy. I have made notations on bottom of each form indicating known "official" outcome summarized herein:

We received a Confidential Record Sheet on Thomas Bayer, but we never received any definite information on the incidents which took place recently.

Please tell us what the convictions concerned in 1972 and 1975. What had Mr. Bayer done to gain him this status?

The incident which you had mentioned recently in Kalamazoo should also be detailed so that we know exactly what took place, what type of an incident occurred and whether or not there will be a trial and sentencing. We must have this information if we are to maintain these individuals on our file and refuse registration.


