

Assault suspect sentenced

Ex-Denver teacher gets 56 years

A former Denver schoolteacher and scoutmaster accused of using money, beer and marijuana to lure teen-age boys into sexual encounters was sentenced to 56 years in prison Wednesday.

Gerald J. Hall, 41, a former sixth-grade teacher at Lincoln Elementary School, was sentenced on 13 counts of sexual assault involving five boys, all under age 15. The sentences, nine of which were higher than the normal maximum of four years, will run consecutively.

Hall was sentenced by Denver District Judge Lynn M. Hufnagel, who convicted Hall March 15 after a non-jury trial. Hufnagel at that time revoked Hall's bond, saying, "I don't believe 16-year-old boys are safe while you are out."

The long prison term even surprised prosecutors. They said it was one of the longest sentences ever handed down for the type of offense.

The normal sentencing range for sexual assault on a child — a Class 4 felony — is two to four years. Prosecutor Diane Balkin had asked for the

maximum sentence, which would have been 52 years. She said Hall used his position of trust as a teacher and scout leader to lure the teen-agers into sexual relationships.

But Hufnagel added time to some of the counts, finding there were aggravating circumstances. She sentenced Hall to eight years on one count and five years each on eight others. She sentenced Hall to two years each on the remaining four counts.

Hall described his life as "a living death" since his arrest. He said he's tried several times to kill himself and asked the court either to sentence him to death or give him help.

But Dr. Kathy Morral, Denver's prison psychiatrist, said Hall has made no effort to rehabilitate himself since being arrested.

In Hall's house, 3057 S. Valentia St., police found more than 100 photographs of boys, some of them nude.

Hall was a teacher in the Denver Public Schools for 11 years.

Ex-teacher guilty of sexual assaults on 5 young boys

Gerald Hall, a former Denver schoolteacher and scoutmaster, was convicted Thursday of sexually assaulting five young boys.

Denver District Court Judge Lynne Hufnagel found Hall guilty of 13 counts of sexual assault on a child. The five young victims were between the ages of 10 and 14.

Hall conceivably could receive a 52-year prison sentence.

Hufnagel revoked Hall's bond and set sentencing for 3:30 p.m. April 16.

One of the children testified at the trial that he had more than 100 sexual encounters with the 41-year-old Hall, who lived at 3057 S. Valentinia St. in Denver.

Hall joined the Denver school system in 1972 and was a scoutmaster in Denver for eight years. Prior to moving to Denver, he had been a scoutmaster for four years in Ogden, Utah.

A key prosecution witness during the trial was Milton Smith, 40, who lived with Hall during two sep-

arate periods — from November 1981 to June 1982 and again from Feb. 5, 1983 to Dec. 12, 1983.

He said that before he moved in with Hall, he and Hall knew of each other's sexual interest in adolescent boys.

"The gist of the conversations was that we shared the same interest, and we talked about individual preferences," Smith testified. "He told me his preference was adolescent males, approximately 13 to 16 years old."

Smith said that the home sometimes was filled with Hall's students and at other times with boys from the Scout troop. There were occasions, he said, when there were only one or two boys at the home and it was at such times that the sexual activity normally occurred.

Smith said some boys were photographed at the house and that a dark room in the house was used to develop the pictures.

In June 1983, police searched the home and confiscated several hundred photographs showing boys in various states of undress.




In regard to your letter of October 3rd on the subject of Gerald J. Hall, a former Scoutmaster of our Council, I am disappointed to have to report, as of this moment, nothing further has developed in this case. While I originally indicated to you, I witnessed substantial evidence that would appear to be just cause for removing this man from the streets - that hasn't occurred at this point, since the arraignment hasn't happened.

I understand from the police department that Mr. Hall's attorney has delayed the arraignment on two or three different occasions and it keeps being rescheduled. That is a frightful commentary on our due process of law.

In regards to his departure from the unit, I should report to you that immediately upon his initial arrest, Mr. Hall phoned the Troop Committee Chairman and notified him of his resignation as Scoutmaster. In addition to that, I believe, the Troop Committee Chairman in order to be sure there were no objections to his further identification with the Boy Scouts of America, delivered a letter indicating he was no longer affiliated with the Boy Scouts of America and the unit in the Denver Area Council. Attached please find a copy of this letter.

Paul, we will make every effort to keep you posted on further developments in this case.

Schoolteacher Is Arrested in Sexual Assault

A Denver schoolteacher and former Boy Scout troop leader was arrested by Denver police Tuesday for investigation of sexual assault on a child, sexual exploitation of a child and patronizing a child prostitute, police reported.

Detective James Lux identified the suspect as Gerald J. Hall, 41, of 3057 S. Valentia St. Hall, a teacher in Denver public schools for 11 years and a scoutmaster in the Denver Boy Scouts for an undetermined period.

The alleged incidents being investigated involve 18 boys, ages 10 to 17, during the period from 1977 to this June, Lux said.

Since June 30, Hall has been on suspension without pay as a sixth-grade teacher at Lincoln Elementary School, pending the outcome of the police investigation, a Denver Public Schools spokesman said. Also, two weeks ago, Hall resigned as a scoutmaster, David McFarland, business manager for the Boy Scouts regional office in Denver, confirmed Tuesday.

After Hall was arrested, he was booked at City Jail and later released on a \$50,000 property bond.

Lux said Hall's home was burglarized early in June, and a juvenile suspect in that burglary provided police with information that led to a two-week investigation that culminated in Hall's arrest Tuesday.

After talking with the burglary suspect early in June, police obtained a warrant to search Hall's home, Detective Michael Mullen said. Executing that warrant on June 15 at the Hall home, police found "several hundred photos, some of them of nude boys and some in sexual acts," Mullen said. Some of the photos were loose and some were in scrapbooks and photo albums, which also were confiscated by police along with camera equipment, Lux said.

Hall joined the Denver school system in September 1972 as a teacher at Place Junior High School, now Place Middle School, said Robert Gould, public information officer for Denver Public Schools. Hall remained at Place Junior High for seven years, until September 1979, when he became a teacher in the sixth grade at Lincoln Elementary School, Gould said.

Detectives Belt Harlan and Larry Moody also are involved in the investigation.
