Please also understand that this decision and the reasons for it will be maintained as confidential as long as you make no attempt

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA leader should be granted or reinstated.

Dear Mr. Stanley,

This is a letter to explain why the committee of the Boy Scout Troop 62 of Bainbridge asked Kip Embley to resign as assistant scoutmaster.

It came to our attention that on a sleep-out at our scout house, January 14, 1983, right before Frozen Trail, Kip was "taking temperatures" of at least four boys, by inserting a thermometer in each boy's rectum. Some boys said "it was for winter survival," and other boys said it was a "boy scout initiation." We confronted Kip, and he said that he did it only on that one occasion. Later we found out that there had been a reoccurrence at the Frozen Trail campout, January 21, 1983, and that it involved at least three boys. For two it was at least a second occurrence.

Coincidently, Kip began a pattern of activity that was unauthorized and we believe unfitting of a scout leader. He began to sleep out at the scout house with a few of the boys between regularly scheduled scouting events. This happened on several occasions. At least one time he slept out at the scout house with only one of the boys. The Scoutmaster nor the committee had knowledge of these events.

The concern of the committee and the parents is that his actions were more than "an initiation." The committee feels that these actscan in no way be tolerated in Boy Scouting, let alone a Boy Scout leader.

The troop committee of Troop 62 strongly recommends that Kip Embley shall not be a counselor at Camp Bashore or Camp Mack. We also strongly recommend that Kip Embley shall not represent the Boy

Scouts of America in any capacity unless:

- 1. Kip Embley seeks and obtains the necessary professional help needed to avoid a reoccurrence of these questionable acts.
- 2. Any unit to which he would be associated is given a complete history of his conduct.

It is this committee's view that our position is both for the good of Kip Embley and that of boys in scouting with whom he may be associated.

We would like to know what action is to be taken by the council. Would you please reply by June 1, 1983.
