### Scout Chief Pleads Guilty to Sex Count

A Casnovia-Kent City scoutmaster whose case jurors could not decide during a March trial in Kent County Circuit Court has pleaded guilty to having sexual contact with one of his former Boy Scouts.

David DeVries, 33, of Grant, had been involved in scouting 18 years before charges of second-degree criminal sexual conduct were

made against him.

He pleaded guilty Monday, the day set for a re-trial before Judge

Robert Benson.

Responding to questions from Benson, DeVries admitted he had some sexual contact with the 11year-old for the purposes of sexual gratification.

During the trial that ended in a hung jury, DeVries on one occa-sion grew angry at the kinds of questions asked by the assistant prosecutor. "You are getting at something sexual and it wasn't," DeVries said, declaiming his innocence.

The incident, which the boy tes tified occurred in the shower afte: he took a swimming test, "never really occurred," argued DeVries lawyer, Gaylor Cardinal.

### Jury Deadlocks in Case Of Kent City Scoutmaster

A Casnovia-Kent City scoutmaster accused of having sexual contact with a Boy Scout continued on bond Thursday after a Kent County Circuit Court jury reported it was deadlocked on charges against him.

David DeVries, 33, of Grant, was on trial for second-degree criminal sexual conduct. After an afternoon. of deliberation, the jurors reported the deadlock to Judge Robert Benson, who said another trial will be scheduled.

DeVries had been involved with scouting for 18 years when accused last October of fondling an 11-year-old who had just completed the test for a merit badge in swimming. The incident allegedly occurred when DeVries and the boy were showering

You should believe the boy, the jurors were told by Barbara Crozier, an assistant prosecutor. No pre-adolescent boy would enat dure the "extreme embarrassment" of telling such a story to 12 strangers and a woman prosecutor if it were not true, she said.

cited "conflicting testimony.

The boy said that during the shower, DeVries had pointed out four areas of the body - under each armpit and on each side of the groin - that could be used as pressure points before applying a tourniquet.

DeVries testified that the boy was intent on finding out about the pressure points. "He asked me, and I showed him," said DeVries. Disagreeing with the direction Crozier's cross-examination was taking, he said, "You are getting at something sexual, and it wasn't."

Crozier asked him if he could tell her of any other situation in which a scoutmaster would demonstrate pressure points on a naked subject. "I don't remember," DeVries said.

DeVries also asserted that his earlier statement to Rockford policemen and a state trooper, in which he said he had washed the boy, was extracted through duress.
