CONFERENCE CONCERNING ACCUSATION MADE AGAINST Russell Blacklock

On November 2, 1983, I met with parents of 13 year old parents of 14 year old

The meeting was held at the request of both parents and was for the purpose of sharing their concerns about the incident involving their sons and Russell Blacklock, which they said occurred in August 1983. Both sons were also present at the meeting.

The two boys explained that after an Order of the Arrow Clan party held by Russell Blacklock, Clan Advisor, at the Community Center, they spent the night in the home of Russell Blacklock. The boys' parents thought other boys were also spending the night.

The boys said that Russell Blacklock gave them permission to drink a glass of wine, while he drank margaritas. After the one glass, he offered them more wine, which they accepted.

The two boys said they bedded down in the living room floor. Russell told them he would sleep in his own bedroom. Instead, he laid down between the two boys.

Both boys stated that during the night Russell rubbed their arms, legs and back.

Sometime during the night went to Russell's bed and slept alone for the rest of the night. Russell stayed on the floor in the living room with

The next day both boys told their parents what had happened.

I explained that Russell Blacklock had been made aware of the accusation by and that he had been relieved of the job of Advisor of the Order of the Arrow Clan and was being denied future registration in Scouting.

The parents said they were considering bringing charges against Mr. Blacklock.

Dear Mr. Blacklock:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America.

You should understand that Boy Scouts of America leadership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of leadership which the Boy Scouts of America seeks to provide for American youth. Please also understand that this decision and the reasons for it will be maintained as confidential.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a Soy Scouts of America leader should be granted or reinstated.
