<u>Subject (1)</u>. -- Since the time that Mr. Francis' registration was approved on a probationary basis, his condition has been satisfactory and his participation level in Scouting has been moderate and appropriate. However, I think that we should continue to monitor Mr. Francis and to restrict his participation to a district level.

Subject (2). -- The first knowledge that the Birmingham Area Council had of Ricky C. Partain came through a letter from registering the concern of Mr. and Mrs. Jr. of Indianapolis over Partain's action in a non-Scout related situation. Our initial investigation did not find Partain registered with a Scout unit; but, we later found that he had been working with a Scout Troop as Assistant Scoutmaster for the past several years. I am personally familiar with the other leaders of Troop 69 where he has had contact, and feel that the incident that they refer to is very likely the first Scout associated complaint to derive from this individual's activities.

During the last week of August, 1984, Tom Adair, Scouting Coordinator for Mountain Chapel United Methodist Church, contacted this office and discussed a complaint that he had received through the Scoutmaster from one set of parents in the troop. The attached "Exhibit A" is the statement received from Mr. Adair registering this situation.

Mr. Adair and other adults in the Troop Committee and the Scoutmaster asked for and received Mr. Partain's resignation (not in writing). The Scoutmaster met with the parents (which did not press any charges), and they seemed to be satisfied with the Scoutmaster's explanation that Partain had resigned.

At this point, we have not been able to receive written, signed statements from anyone else regarding the matter, and the Troop Committee feels that matters should be dropped.

At this time, I am recommending by "Confidential Record Sheet - Appendix B" that Ricky Carl Partain not be allowed to register in the Boy Scouts of America in any capacity. We will continue to monitor his activities and that of age 15, who is currently registered as a member of Troop 69.

Something has been brought to our attention that I feel is in order to abare with you in the event the man in question is a Scouter in your council as he implies. He may very well not be.

Rick Partain (white male in his late 20's) and residing at 529 Willow Lane, Birmingham, Alabama 35206 (Tel. No. 205-836-4123) was en route from Birmingham, Alabama, to Lincoln, Nebraska, this past week with an II year old boy named RR #3, Box 95, Pinson, Alabama, when his brown Chevy van had motor trouble here in the Indianapolis area. Partain is apparently a wrestling coach and very active in wrestling circles. The II year old was apparently a wrestler.

Acquaintances of Partain from wrestling activities, Mr. and Mrs. Jr., 820 West 79th Street, Indianapolis (Tel. 317-257-7710) invited Partain and the boy to stay at their home from Tuesday, March 9th to Friday, March 12th while the van was being repaired. They cancelled the trip to Lincoln, Nebraska, and headed back to Birmingham on the 12th.

The concern stems from the fact that there was evidence during the stay at the home that Partain made sexual advances to the boy, and the boy at one point was heard to shout "No, no coach - you can't make me do it." Mrs. also was shocked to find the two in bed together on Thursday night.

They felt so strongly about the liklihood of a problem that they felt if the man was indeed in Scouting, the local council in Birmingham should be made aware of it. It is in that spirit that I pass this along.
