After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America.

You should understand that BSA leadership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of leadership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth. Please also understand that this decision and the reasons for it will be maintained as confidential.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claims that your registration as a BSA leader should be granted or reinstated.

It would appear that no immediate change will be made in my involvement with Catholic youth programs. Since I will not be involved in Boy Scout functions another person should be named to replace me on the Advisory Board. I suggest the newly appointed Chaplain. Bill Markey. I gave Harvey Bill's address on Friday.

I also want to clarify restrictions placed on my visiting Bartle. It is my intent to accompany a work crew in May to help get the Chapel and Chaplain's Cabin ready for the summer. I will also be present for the opening Mass on Tribal Feast week-end. After that I will be present at Bartle only to visit Tim or to attend Mass on Sunday mornings. My visit with Tim would include attending Mic-O-Say ceremonials where he is participating. It is my understanding from our conversation that this involvment does not go beyond your expectations. I certainly do not want any confrontation about my presence at Bartle.

I will continue to "sleep on" my options and will let you know as soon as one is chosen.

I had an opportunity to talk to James A. Kennedy at the National Catholic Scouters Conference in Kansas City this week and find that he and his family currently live in Arrowrock, Missouri, and he is still working for the County Family Services for the State of Missouri in Saline County.

I believe that this activity (the National Catholic Scouters Conference) served as his final contact with Scouting through the church. I believe that we should continue him on a probationary status with the idea that it is his prerogative to ask to be reinstated, and as of this date he has not requested that. I do think that perhaps, Faul, an inquiry to the council in Columbia, Missouri might be in order to see if he has attempted to be registered, even though our national file should have caught it.

Please consider this an official request to keep James A. Kennedy on probation for at least one more year.
