Kelsey Case Continues

Lewis Kesley was bound over to Circuit Court today on two counts of second degree criminal sexual conduct after a preliminary examination in District Court before Judge William Stapieton.

Plea Bargain Accepted in Kelsey Case

An Arcadia man, charged with sex crimes against young boys, entered a guilty plea in Circuit Court Friday before Judge Charles Wickens, who accepted the plea.

Lewis Charles Kelsey, 61, of Box 89, Fourth Street, Arcadia, pleaded guilty to a charge of one count of second degree criminal sexual conduct. The plea bargain came a week before Kesley was set to appear in Circuit Court on seven counts of second degree criminal sexual conduct lodged against him in November and January.

Kelsey was involved in Boy Scout organization activities until he resigned about a week prior to his November arrest. He was employed as a laborer for Orchard Beach State Park and was a junitor for about 10 years in the Onekama Consolidated School District until 1981.

Sentencing will be at a later date.

Kelsey MAY Sentenced 1984

An Arcadia man who pleaded guilty to second degree criminal sexual conduct was sentenced to six moriths in jail and three years probation in Circuit Court this morning.

Lewis Charles Kelsey, 61, Fourth Street, Arcadia, was sentenced by Judge. Charles Wickens to Jall and probation plus \$250 in fines and \$250 in court, costs.

Keisey pleaded guilty to a charge of one count of second degree criminal sexual conduct in April. Wickens accepted that plea. Keisey was charged previously with seven counts of second degree criminal sexual conduct lodged against him in November 1983 and December 1984.

He was involved in Boy Scout organization activities until he resigned about a week prior to his November arrest. He was employed as a laborer for Crichard Beach State Park and was a janitor for about 10 years in the Onekama Consolidated School District until 1981.

Judge Charles Wickens refused to accept a guilty plea on those charges in Circuit Court Jan. 17 and remanded the case back to District Court for a pre-liminary examination.

Kelsey now goes to trial on those two charges plus five other charges of second degree criminal sexual conduct. The first five were lodged in November; the second two in January. No date has been set for the trial.

Second degree criminal sexual conduct usually involves sexual conduct or contact (short of penetration) with children. The maximum penalty is 15 years in a state prison.

Kelsey, 61, of Box 89, Fourth Street. Arcadia, was employed as a laborer for Orchard Beach State Park at the time of his arrest in November and was a janitor for about 10 years in the Onekarna Consolidated School District until 1981. Light sentence angers mother of molested son

MANISTEE — (UPI) — An Onekama woman says she's outraged that a judge has given a light sentence to the former Boy Scout leader convicted of molesting her son and six other scouts.

Manistee County Circuit Judge Charles Wickens sentenced Lewis Keisey, 61, of Arcadia, to six months in jail and three years' probation. He also-ordered the former janitor to pay \$500 in fines and costs and to seek counseling.

The sentence was handed down this week after Wickens accepted Kelsey's guilty plea to one count of second-degree criminal sexual conduct. Kelsey originally was charged with seven counts.

Keisey, a janitor with the Onekama Consolidated School District until 1981, could have been sentenced to five years in prison.

"I COULD NOT believe the judge would let a child molester get six months in jail," mother of one of the boys, said in an interview with the Manistee News-Advoxate.

"He did not consider what the boys and the parents went through.... I can't believe that this can happen in this day and age," she said. "He molested boys and gets away with it so he can turn around and do it again. That's not justice."

said her 12-year-oid son — who was 11 at the time of the incidents — kept silent because Keisey told Alm his stepfather didn't leve him, would think he was a "dirty boy" and would send him away from his mother to live with his natural father.

Keisey, who resigned from scouting just before his arraignment last year, also bought the seven boys' trust and silence with gifts and special treatment, said.

Kolsey was employed as a laborer for the Orchard Beach Satz Park at the case of his arrest.

Kelsey Case Goes Back To District Court

Judge Charles Wickens refused to accept a guilty plea to charges of second degree criminal sexual conduct from Lewis Charles Kelsey in Circuit Court today; and the court remanded the case back to District Court for a preliminary examination.

To date, Keisey has been charged with seven counts of second degree criminal sexual conduct. The first five were lodged in November, the second two in January.

A second degree criminal sexual conduct charge usually involves sexual conduct or contact (short of penetration) with children under 13 years of age or between the ages of 13 and 16 in family cases. The maximum penalty is 15 years in a state prison.

Keisey, 61, of Box 89; Fourth Street, Arcadia, was employed at the time of his arrest in November as a laborer for Orchard Beach State Park and was a janitor until 1981 in the Onekarna Consolidated School System. He was active in Boy Scout activities until he resigned about a week before his arrest.

Dear Paul:

Enclosed is a confidential file report form on former Scouter, Louis Kelsey, who has been registered in our Council for some 20 years as a District Committeeman, District Commissioner, and various unit positions. I am sure that the record, as shown in the newspaper clippings, is correct, in that I was personally involved in his resignation, and worked with the State Police on the case. As much as I can tell from my investigation, these sexual misconduct activities were done with young boys in the age group 9-12, and, as far as we can gather, were all done in his home. We have not discovered any misconduct at a Troop meeting, or Cub or Scout activity. This man was even a volunteer provisional scoutmaster at our camp for portions of many summers. We only made a light investigation into his camp activities, and could find no sexual misconduct there.

We are fairly certain that these charges definitely did involve Cub Scouts, although, no parents have contacted this office, or any other members of the District Committee.

After I discussed the matter with you last Thursday, by phone, I followed your suggestion and contacted Barkley Bollas with regard to the Detroit Free Press picking up this matter, and I also contacted Bill Downs, since this man was a Vigil member of the Order of the Arrow. I am, therefore, sending a confidential carbon copy of this letter to Mr. Bollas and Mr. Downs, in case they are contacted.

Bob Birkemeier and Ren Metzgar, of the East Central Region, are also aware of this matter.

Dear Mr. Ernst:

About three years ago Mr. Louis Kelsey of Arcadia Michigan, was convicted on a charge of child molestation involving Webelos Cub Scouts. He was registered with Cub Pack #63 of this Council, located in Onekama, Michigan. He was also registered on the Great Lakes District Committee of this Council. At that time, we mutually placed his name in the confidential file.

After that date, the Council was sued for letting him be involved in Scouting and I believe Risk Management settled the matter for some \$13,500.

I am enclosing the front page of the Manistee News Advocate, dated Friday, November 22, 1985. (I received this copy only a few days ago.) An article on this page shows that he violated his probation and is back in jail. $\ensuremath{\mathsf{I}}$ understand that the probation violation did not involve any members of the Boy Scouts of America, and therefore, we are not involved at this time.

This article should probably be added to his file.

Kelsey Sentenced

Charles L. Kelsey, 63, of Arcadia, was sentenced Thursday in 19th Circuit Court to a two- to 15-year prison term by special judge William Peterson for a probation violation of a 1984 criminal sexual conduct conviction, reported Jim Ribbey, probation officer.

Kelsey was convicted May 15, 1984 of CSCII, sexual contact with a minor. In October of this year, Judge James Batzer removed himself from the case after Kelsey's attorney motioned for Batzer to disqualify himself on the grounds that this case became a campaign issue last year.

Kelsey was convicted of the probation violation in September by visiting judge John Huft. The probation order stipulated that he not associate with minors without supervision.

Kelsey was given credit of 163 days for time served.
