I was pleased that Scouting received no adverse publicity. Judd was a Scout leader for 12 years, but has not been active for the last two years.



## Former Teacher Sentenced for Sex Offenses

Mack Judd. a. former Victoria school teacher, was assessed three concurrently set 5-year prison sentences Wednesday afternoon after pleading noio contendere; (no contest) to indictments alleging sex offenses with three male

Judd, 40, also a former president of two teachers groups here, entered the pleas before Judge Joe E. Keily, presiding judge of the Fourth Administrative Judicial District.

Judd, who was a Patti Welder Intermediate School shop teacher under the special education program when the three indictments were returned March 2, was taken to Victoria County Jail after the proceedings.

His attorney, Arthur Lapham, said the convictions will not be appealed. Criminal District Attorney George

Filley III requested that Kelly consider the sentence recommendations which he said resulted from plea bargaining.

Filley also advised Kelly that the state was abandoning the second count of one of the indictments.

Maximum punishment in each of the second degree felony cases was a 20-year prison term and a \$10,000

. Lapham informed Kelly that Judd was competent to face the charges and never intended to claim an insanity defense despite being admitted at Citizens Memorial Hospital under the care of a psychiatrist, on the day the indictments were returned.

Filley said Judd was served with a grand jury subpoena on the day prior to the session.

Judd remained in the hospital until May 15. He was taken into custody but was released on his personal recognizance until the following day when he posted three \$1,500 cash bonds.

The indictments against Judd, who resides on Benbow Road near Inez, charged him with indecency with a child, sexual abuse of a child and sexual assault.

Filley said two of the indictments arose out of activity at Judd's home and the third indictment charged him with an incident at the school.

Judd was also a former foster parent licensed by the Department of Human Resources.

Filley said the indecency with a child indictment alleged an incident with a 14-year-old boy on Feb. 21. It charged him with engaging in sexual contact with the boy, who was

He said the sexual abuse of a child indictment charged Judd with committing an offense with a boy, now 17, on March 5, 1982. It charged him with engaging in deviate sexual intercourse with the

Filley said the sexual assault indictment accused Judd of incidents last Dec. 15 with another 14-year-old boy, who was

The latter indictment alleged deviate action but with more explicit language.

The indictment carried two counts one of which was dropped by the state Wednesday.

Filley said the investigation was referred to his office by officers in the Victoria Police Department and the Victoria County Sheriff's Department who in turn received a referral from Children's Services.

Judd submitted his resignation later in March to the Victoria Independent School District board of trustees which formally accepted the resignation at an April meeting.

However, Judd remained on paid sick leave status until June 1.

After the fall-winter term grand jury returned the indictments, District Judge Clarence N. Stevenson granted a 90-day extension of the term, effective March 10, when foreman John Robert Thomas III requested a need for time for further investigation of the case.

Filley said the grand jury reconvened March 9 bur took no further action.

Judd had been an active member of the local chapter of the Texas State Teachers Association and former president of the local chapter as well as former president of the Victoria Classroom Teachers Association. He was also a former president of District 3 of TSTA.

Judd briefly served as president of the Political Action League in mid-1983 when a teachers-dominated slate took over the group.

He was voted out at the first meeting after he was elected.

### Grand Jury Reconvenes On Teacher Allegations

The Victoria County Grand Jury, which returned three sex offense indictments on March 2 against Mack Judd, 39, a special education teacher at Patti Weider Intermediate School, will reconvene for another special session at 9 a.m. Friday.

Criminal District Attorney George Filley III said Friday's session "will be limited to the ongoing investigation."

District Judge Clarence N. Stevenson has granted a request from grand jury foreman John Robert Thomas III for a 90-day extension of the fall-winter term for "further investigation" of the case.

The extension becomes effective Saturday when the fall-winter term

Stevenson granted the request after the three indictments were returned.

Meanwhile, a spokesman at Citizens Memorial Hospital reported Thursday tight that Judd had been moved from private room to another portion of the hospital.

The spokesman declined to give Judd's condition.

Filley said Judd had been served with a subpoena to appear before the March 2 special session of the grand jury but that he did not make an appearance.

He said he was informed that afternoon by Judd's attorney, Robert Seerden, that Judd had been admitted to the hospital.

The indictments charge Judd, a shop teacher in the special education program, with indecency with a child, sexual abuse of a child and sexual assault, the latter indictment carrying two counts.

They allege offenses on three occasions over a two-year period with three male

Judd is accused of committing the offenses on two 14-year-old boys, both presently Judd's Judd's Judd's Dec. 15 and Feb. 21, and a former student, who is now 17, on March 5, 1982.

Filley said two of the indictments arise out of activities that allegedly occurred at Judd's residence on Benbow Road, near Inez, while the third indictment alleges an offense at the

In that connection, Filley said Judd is a former licensed foster parent, a fact confirmed by Dick Wearden, supervisor of Children's Services, and Lucy Holder, child protection specialist of foster home development for the Department of Human Resources.

Both explained that foster parents are licensed by the Department of Human Resources and are referred to Children's Services after seven weeks of careful screening and testing.

The childen are placed in the homes by Children's Services.

Wearden said that when "we heard of an inkling of what could be happening, we told the man we couldn't use him any more."

"Sometimes last year the home (Judd's foster care home) was closed," Mrs. Holder said.

Neither could remember the date because they were away from their offices.

"I believe it was September," Wearden said.

Judd briefly served as a president of the Political Action League in mid-1983 when a teachers-dominated slate took over the group.

He was voted out at the first meeting after he was elected.

# Jury Indicts Shop Teacher

Mack-rludd, 39, a Patti Welder Intermediate School shop teacher under the special education program, was named Friday afternoon in three Indictments alleging sex offenses on three male students on three occasions over a two-year period.

The indictments charge Judd, a former president of two teachers groups here, with indecency with a child, sexual abuse of a child and sexual assault, the latter indictment carrying two counts.

Thomas III, pointing to a need for time for "further investigation," of the case, was granted a request to have the fall-winter grand jury term extended for 80 days.

District Judge Clarence N. Stevenson granted the request for extension

of the term from the original ending. Filley said he understood that Judd time of March 10.

The grand jury had met for its last regular scheduled session of the term on Feb. 24 and was called back Friday for a special session.

Criminal District Altorney George Filley III said Judd was served Thursday afternoon with a subpoena to appear before the grand jury but did not make an appearance and entered Citizens Memorial Hospital sometimes Friday.

He said Judd, who resides on Benbow Road near Inez, was admitted to the hospital by a physician specializing in internal medicine.

He was admitted to a private room and was reported in fair condition Friday night.

"I signed and issued the grand jury subpoena and it was served yesterday afternoon by Detective Larry Leon," Filley said. Filley said he understood that Judd was in the office of his attorney, Robert Seerden, Friday morning.

"I was advised by his attorney this afternoon that he had been admitted to the hospital."

Judd is an active member of the local chapter of the Texas State Teachers Association and former president of the local chapter as well as former president of the Victoria Classroom Teachers Association. He was also a former president of District 3 of TSTA.

Superintendent Roger Gee learned of Judd's indictment Friday afternoon from an Advocate reporter.

"I was not aware of an indictment," he said. "It's awfully hard to comment."

Gee said he did not know exactly what Judd's legal status in the district (See INDICTED, Page 12A)


