I really need more personal information, and physical characteristics if this is available anywhere.

My difficulty is that many times neither you or I are on our same job when an inquiry comes in. It is very diffult to refuse registration unless our files are very complete. The legal world today also makes it more difficult to do some of those things which we have tried to do for years.

I am writing in regard to your letters of January 26th concerning Alfred J. Conrad and February 3 concerning Fred A. Cram.

In regard to Conrad he was convicted and sentenced to five years in jail. I do not have any additional information regarding him. Staff and volunteers have changed substantially in the last two years and I have been unable to find enough information to fill out a Confidential Record sheet.

In regard to Cram, again I do not have details on what actually happened, however, the indication is that he picked up some youngsters to go to camp but ended up in a motel with them. The unit that he was registered in was due to recharter at the time of his conviction, so we worked through the sponsoring organization letting him know he would not be reregistered and could no longer be registered in Scouting.

Have been notified today by the Criminal Investigation Division of the State of Maine that one Alfred J. Conrad has been arrested on a morals and sodomy charge. Conrad was registered with the Pine Tree Council on Troop 647, Hallowell, Maine for the years 1979 - 1978 - and 1977 as SA. Address given at that time was 150 Green Street, Apt. 4, Augusta, Maine 04330. Troop 647 was dropped for the year 1980 and picked up again in 181. Conrad has not been registered with the Pine Tree Council since 179 on Troop 647, however, he should be run through your computer, just in case.

Arraignment will be after the first of the year. We will be in touch with the proper information for your confidential file as soon as he is brought to trial.
