A 30-year-old Worcester man was arrested about 3 p.m. yesterday on warrants from the Worcester and West Boylston police departments charging sexual and other offenses.

Edward C. Brown of 9 Jaques Ave. was booked at 5:30 p.m. and charged with three counts of rape of a child under 16, three counts of assault and battery on a child under 14, and seven

nts of posing or exhibiting a child a state of nudity or sexual conduct.

Brown was held on \$5,000 cash bail pending his appearance in Central District Court this morning.

The arrest was the culmination of a long investigation by Worcester Juvenile Officers James M. Shugrue and John R. Harrington and West Boylston Police Officer Louis LaRose.

Man Sentenced to 1 Day To Life in Morals Case

Edward C. Brown, 30, formerly of 9 Jaques Ave., who pleaded guilty March 2 to nine morals offenses, was sentenced yesterday to a term of one day to life at the Bridgewater State Hospital sex treatment center after admitting in Superior Court that he is sexually dangerous.

He had pleaded guilty to six counts of soliciting a child to pose for pornographic purposes and three counts of unnatural child rape. He has been undergoing evaluation at Bridgewater.

Yesterday he told Judge Herbert F. Travers Jr. he wished to waive his right to a hearing on the issue and admit he issexually design out in need of treat. ment. After determining that Brown's admission was intelligently made and voluntary, Travers declared him sexually dangerous and passed sentence. The law permits periodic review of such sentences to determine if a person's condition has changed.

The six pornography indictments alleged soliciting a child under 18 to pose for pornographic purposes in Worcester and West Boylston Dec. 17 and in Worcester Dec. 20 and 23 and twice Dec. 25. The rapes occurred Dec. 17 in Worcester and West Boylston and Dec. 23 in Worcester, according to the indictments and Brown's admissions, tor Travers.

City Man's Rape Case Is Continued to Jan. 23

The case of a Worcester man facing rape and other morals charges involving a child under the age of 16, was continued yesterday to Jan. 23.

Central District Court Judge William J. Luby set bail of \$75,000 with surety or \$7,500 cash for the defendant, Edward C. Brown, 30, of 9 Jaques Ave.

Brown is charged with three counts of rape and abuse of a child under 16, three counts of a morals offense, and seven counts of posing or exhibiting a child in a state of nudity or sexual conduct. A public defender was appointed to represent him.

According to court documents, the charges were lodged in connection with incidents that took place from about Dec. 11 to Dec. 25 and involved five different boys.

Brown was arrested Thursday on warrants from the Worcester and West Boylston police departments. The arrest came after a long investigation by Worcester Juvenile Division Officers James M. Shugrue and John Harrington and West Boylston Police Officer Louis LaRose

West Boylston and Worcester police said yesterday the investigation is ongoing and they did not want to release any further information for fear that it would hinder the investigation.


