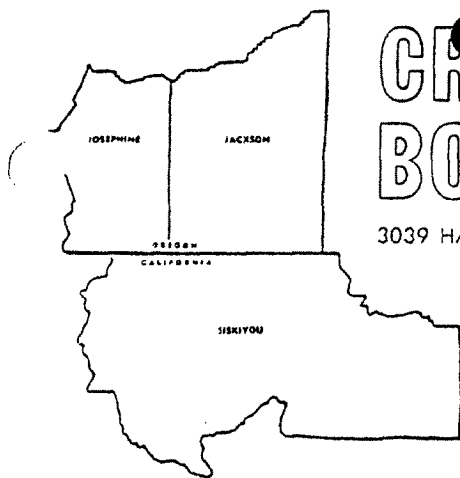

Enclosed is a copy of the Case Report for Mr. Richard Allen Backes, 1017 West 10th Street, Medford, Oregon.

As you can see Mr. Backes was arrested on Oct. 12, 1978 for First Degree Sodomy and convicted of that crime on March 29, 1979.

According to our records Mr. Backes was registered as a member of the committee for Explorer Post 5, sponsored by the Jackson County Sheriffs office from January 1975 through December 1977. He was then registered as an associate Advisor from January 1978 through December of that same year. When the post reregistered for 1979 Mr. Backes' name had been crossed off.

About two weeks ago Mr. Backes came to the Crater Lake Council office and picked up registration forms for a new Explorer Post. He made contact with several Order of the Arrow members and asked for their help in starting an Explorer Post in Search and Rescue to be sponsored by the Sheriffs office. He even visited our High Adventure Summer Camp and recruited potential members for the new post.

This brought the matter to my attention and I notified the Sheriff who was not aware of Mr. Backes or his desire to be an Explorer Advisor. He did some checking and was the first to learn of Mr. Backes' criminal record.

At 2035 hours on 10-12-78, writer was contacted at the counter by [REDACTED] of 1013 W. 10th Street, Medford, phone 773-2547. He advised writer that his son, [REDACTED] and his son, [REDACTED] had, in conversation with him, advised him that they had sexual relations with a neighbor of his at 1017 W. 10th Street, Medford. Mr. [REDACTED] advised writer that his son, [REDACTED] 8 years of age, had advised him that Richard Backes, living at 1017 W. 10th Street, Medford, had taken [REDACTED] into his bedroom upstairs, that in the bedroom subject Backes had shown his son [REDACTED] pornographic pictures and that subject Backes then became aroused and removed the pants of [REDACTED] and manipulated [REDACTED] penis.

Writer, in contacting [REDACTED] at 1013 W. 10th Street, DOB 05-19-70, [REDACTED] advised that on 10-11-78 he had accompanied Richard Backes to his bedroom at 1017 W. 10th Street, stated that they were working on reloading ammunition. He stated that Mr. Backes was a friend of his and that they often went to his bedroom and looked at his guns and worked on the reloading equipment in that area. [REDACTED] further stated that upon entering the room, Mr. Backes accompanied him to the bed and at this time produced magazines with nude women in them and showed them to him. [REDACTED] stated at this time Mr. Backes reached over and grabbed shold of [REDACTED] pants and unzipped them and pulled them down to his knees. He stated at this point Mr. Backes began fondling [REDACTED] penis. After manipulating [REDACTED] penis for a short period of time, Mr. Backes pulled his pants down to his knees and began masturbating himself. He stated that then Mr. Backes put his head down and took [REDACTED] penis in his mouth and commenced to lick it. After this there was some conversation between Mr. Backes and [REDACTED] and in this conversation Mr. Backes was explaining to [REDACTED] various things related to the facts of life. Mr. Backes then lay back on the bed and masturbated until he ejaculated. [REDACTED] stated that he observed a white liquid coming from Mr. Backes' penis. After this Mr. Backes showed the sperm to [REDACTED]

and advised him that this produced a baby in a woman.

Writer took a taped statement from [REDACTED] relating this before-mentioned material and that will be enclosed in this case.

Writer then contacted [REDACTED] of 1013 W. 10th Street, DOB 04-11-45, 13 years of age. [REDACTED] advised writer that over the Labor Day week end he had gone on a camping trip with Richard Backes and that they had gone to somewhere in the area of the Tiller Forest District. He stated that he thought they were in a location near Snow Lake. He stated that Mr. Backes had advised him and his mother that there would be several people on this camping trip with them and that he was going to teach survival techniques to the people on the trip. He stated that as it turned out no one else went on the trip and that the camping trip consisted of him and Mr. Backes. Upon setting up camp Mr. Backes set up a tent and when bedtime came Mr. Backes advised subject [REDACTED] that they should zip their sleeping bags together in order to keep warm during the night. [REDACTED] then advised me that Mr. Backes removed all of his clothing, stating to [REDACTED] that he never wore any clothing when he was sleeping in a down sleeping bag as they were too warm. [REDACTED] stated that he went to sleep and during the night he was awakened by Richard Backes, who at this time was rubbing his hand on [REDACTED] penis. [REDACTED] advised that he told Mr. Backes not to do that. Mr. Backes advised that everyone did this. He stated that Mr. Backes continued to rub on his penis for a short period of time and that after this, Mr. Backes pulled the sleeping bag down and that Mr. Backes leaned over, putting [REDACTED] penis in his mouth. [REDACTED] advised writer that Mr. Backes continued manipulating his penis in this manner for some time and that Mr. Backes then raised up and asked him how he liked it. [REDACTED] advised Mr. Backes at this time that he did not like and Mr. Backes then rolled over in the sleeping bag and began masturbating. [REDACTED] stated at this time Mr. Backes reached over and grabbed hold of

After this Mr. Backes again reached for the _____ hand and he again refused to masturbate Mr. Backes. Mr. Backes masturbated and _____ stated to _____ a white liquid coming from Mr. Backes' penis and that Mr. Backes advised that this was what made babies and that he wiped it off with a cloth, showing it to _____ as he did so.

Writer proceeded to 1017 W. 10th Street. At that address writer contacted the father of _____ Backes, advising subject that we needed to talk to his son. Shortly thereafter his son arrived at the front door. I asked the subject to step out on the front porch and he did so. At this time I advised the subject he was under arrest for First Degree Sodomy and attempted to advise the subject of his Constitutional Rights. Writer read the complete instructions of the Miranda Rights to Mr. Backes, however at this time I did not receive any acknowledgement that he understood them. _____

_____ handcuffed with his hands behind his back and placed in the rear of writer's patrol car. Writer was assisted at _____ W. 10th Street by Officer Reed, who was riding in the same patrol car as writer. At this time writer advised the father of Mr. Backes that Mr. Backes was being arrested for First Degree Sodomy. Mr. Backes was transported to the Medford Police Department, where writer and Officer Reed transported Backes over to the detectives' side where writer had conversation with Mr. Backes. Prior to this conversation and witnessed by Officer Reed, writer advised the subject of his Constitutional Rights. At this time Mr. Backes advised that he understood each of the individual advisements.

Writer, in conversation with Mr. Backes, Mr. Backes stated that he had been in his bedroom with subject _____ and that _____ had observed certain erotic magazines belonging to Mr. Backes, under the bed in his bedroom, and that he had asked Mr. Backes if he could look at them. Mr. Backes advised that he could. He stated that after a short period of time looking at the magazines, _____ told Mr. Backes that he had a partner. Mr. Backes then asked the subject what he usually did with this and _____ stated, "I do what my brother does." At this point _____ pulled down his pants and began masturbating in front of Mr. Backes, according to Mr. Backes. He stated that after masturbating for a short period

of time he advised that he had to go to the bathroom. At this point Mr. Backes stated that he reached over and touched [redacted] penis in order to keep him from urinating on the bed. After this, subject [redacted] went to the bathroom. At this point Mr. Backes advised that he had also been looking at the magazines and he became aroused. He stated that after returning from the bathroom, [redacted] had asked him several sex related questions and that at this point he masturbated in order to produce sperm that he could show to [redacted] in order to educate him on the making of babies. Writer asked Mr. Backes if he had at any time placed his mouth on the sex organ of [redacted] and he stated that he could not remember having done it. Writer asked Mr. Backes if he always remembered everything when he was in a state of arousal and Mr. Backes stated that he did not, that lots of times when he was having sex with women he would blank the entire episode and would not remember it. Writer asked Mr. Backes if it was possible he had forgotten having put his mouth on [redacted] penis, and he stated that it was possible, as he did have these blackout spells when he was having sex. Mr. Backes advised that after he climaxed he wiped the liquid from his penis with a rag and showed it to subject [redacted] advising him that this was sperm and that it fertilized the female egg and produced a baby. Writer asked Mr. Backes about his episode with [redacted] on the camping trip and he stated that he remembered the camping trip, that they were supposed to be accompanied by several friends of his and that none of the friends had shown up and that they had camped on a Friday night and a Saturday night in the area near Snow Lake, which is apparently off of Jackson Creek near Tillier, Oregon. He stated that upon camping at that location, they had set up a tent and that they had zipped their sleeping bags together in order to keep warm and that it was raining the night of the encampment. After a short time in the sleeping bag Mr. Backes and [redacted] began conversing. He stated that they were talking about their various sexual experiences and that upon talking about these experiences they both became aroused.

He stated that [REDACTED] then began masturbating while in the sleeping bag and that he also masturbated. [REDACTED] stated that he became aroused to the state that he felt he was going to climax, that he got out of the bag, and he went outside of the tent in order to finish his masturbating, where he would not mess up the sleeping bag. [REDACTED] stated that he could not ever remember touching [REDACTED] penis and that he did not remember having sex with [REDACTED] penis, however he stated that he was subject to these memory lapses when he was in a state of arousal. [REDACTED] stated that it would be possible for him to have forgotten these incidents.

Writer took typed statements from [REDACTED] and also a typed statement from [REDACTED] Allen Backes. In writer's conversation with Mr. Backes, he advised writer that the books that had been in the room which [REDACTED] had read, were still there. Writer asked Mr. Backes if he minded if writer looked at the books and he stated, no, that he did not. At this point Mr. Backes made a telephone call to his father, advising him to go into his bedroom and remove these books and give them to Officer Reed when he went to that location. Officer Reed returned approximately five minutes later with the books and they were tagged and placed in the Madford Police Precinct room. Mr. Backes was lodged in the Jackson County Jail on charge of First Degree Sodomy. At time of this report, [REDACTED] has no further information on this case. End of report.
