In separate incidents — Two charged with indecent exposure

A Broken Arrow man who was employed this week as a school bus driver and also serves as a Boy Scout leader, was charged Tuesday with indecent exposure. David Raymond West, 40, 711 S.W. 14th St., has been charged in Tulsa County District Court with one count of indecent exposure after a former felony conviction. Broken Arrow Police Det. H.C. Miller said West, clad in a Boy Scout leader's uniform, was arrested on the felony warrant at his home Tuesday night.

The detective said the charge

stems from an April 24 incident in which an 18-year-old female was walking in the 600 block of North 14th Street. West, sitting on a front porch, allegedly began a conversation with the woman, then exposed himself.

The woman fled the scene and notified police, said Miller. She later identified West in a photo lineup.

According to police records, West was convicted of aggravated indecent solicitation of a child (a felony) in 1972 in Lawrence, Kan.

A spokesman at the transportation center for Broken Arrow Public Schools said West was employed Monday as a school bus driver.

The Tulsa headquarters for Boy Scouts of America confirmed that West is leader of a Webelos pack, but did not know which Broken Arrow pack he heads. The BSA spokesman did not know how long West has been

a Boy Scout leader. The Webelos rank in Boy Scouts is for boys who are 10 years old or who have completed the fourth grade and is a transition rank between Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts.

West's preliminary hearing has been set for a May 14. He remains in Tulsa County Jail on \$20,000 bond.

In a separate but similar case, police arrested Todd Damon Banks, 24, 1659 S. College St., Tuesday in connection with two incidents of indecent exposure.

Miller said two counts of indecent exposure were filed against Banks in Tulsa County District Court.

Banks is accused of exposing himself before a female clerk at a gas station at Aspen (145th East Avenue) and Washington (91st Street) on April 8 and again on April 28.

On the first incident, Banks allegedly walked inside and (See Exposure, page Two)

made a purchase before exposing himself. On Sunday, he is accused of driving up to the window — while wearing no clothes — and asking for directions from

the same clerk, said the detective.

Miller said the victim positively identified Banks in a photo lineup.
