On January 27, 1986, the Defendant, Richard Lee Pollock, appeared in person with his attorney, John Logan. The State appeared by Assistant County Attorney, Mona Knoll.

The Defendant withdrew the plea of not guilty previously entered and thereupon entered a plea of guilty to the charge filed in the Information, namely, Count II, Lascivious Acts With a Child, in violation of Section(s) 709.8 of The Iowa Code.

The Court specifically finds that the plea is voluntarily entered with an understanding of the charge, a knowledge of the criminal consequences and the constitutional rights waived by the plea, that there exists a factual basis supporting the charge and said plea is accepted and entered of record.

Defendant was advised that any challenge to the plea of guilty based on alleged defects in the plea proceeding must be first raised by motion in arrest of judgment in order to assert such challenge on appeal.

The Defendant waived the right to further time and requested immediate sentencing.

No legal cause having been shown why judgment and sentence should not be pronounced, .

IT IS THE JUDGMENT OF THE COURT THAT the Defendant, Richard Lee Pollock is guilty of the offense of Lascivious Acts With a Child, in violation of Section(s) 709.8 of The Iowa Code.

THE DEFENDANT IS COMMITTED to the custody of the Director of

Defendant's appearance bond is exonerated.

The temporary custody of the Defendant shall remain with the Sheriff of Linn County pending Defendant's transfer to the custody of the Director. Linn County shall pay the costs of temporarily confining the Defendant and transporting the Defendant to the state institution where he is to be confined in execution of this judgment.

This Court recommends that the Board of Parole follow its usual rules, regulations and guidelines in determining when the Defendant would be eligible for release or parole.

The Defendant is given credit for 103 days served on this charge.

The Defendant is taxed the costs of prosecution.

The Defendant was advised of his right of appeal. Appeal bond is set in the sum of \$5,000.00.

Sentencing was entered pursuant to Rule 9, the Court agreeing to be bound by the terms of a plea agreement. The Court and the State recommend that Defending be incarcerated at a state institution such as Clarinda.

Police say the incidents occurred between May 1 and June 30 while Pollock was living with the three boys.

Pollock remained in the Linn County Jail Wednesday evening under \$11,500 bond.


