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To Whom it may Concern:

My name is American citizen, resident of Lorenzo, Texas and former Troop Committee Chairman for Boy Scout Troop 399, Lorenzo, Texas. This statement regards the moral character of one Dr. R. Ted Means, former scoutmaster and former resident of Lorenzo, Texas. The following specific instances involving my son, and Dr. Means, forces me to be convinced that Dr. Means is unfit for service in Scouting.

- Several times, on numerous campouts, fir.
 Means practiced hypnotism on the boys. This
 was done, supposedly, as entertainment.
- 2. The older boyscouts, (included) got together and requested that foul language on campouts be forbidden. I was told this was done because Dr. Means cursed so excessively.
- My son, (age 13) was called into Dr.
 Means' office one day last summer, 1970, on
 Scout business. After an informal chat, Dr.
 Means held up a prophylactic and asked him
 if he knew what it was used for. Dr. Means
 then proceeded to draw it onto his own finger
 and explain to how it was used. (and did
 not tell us of this episode until I asked him
 in December, 1970, if Dr. Means had approached
 him sexually in any way.)

The above three instances were reported to me confidentally and in person, by my son, who was active in Scouting the entire time Dr. Means was Scoutmaster.

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Attached hereto is a copy of a letter which my husband & County Attorned wrote to the ethic committee of Osteopathic doctors in the State of Texas. This letter describes in detail an incident involving our son and one Dr. Robert Ted Means while he was residing in Lorenzo, Texas, and was at that time working with Boy Scouts as their leader.

It is out of concern for other young people and Dr. Means himself that we feel that it would be most unwise and even dangerous for Dr. Means to work with Boy Scouts in any capacity. By his own admission to me, he knows that he cannot control his own actions when he is in the presence of boys.

At any time further confidential information is needed in this regard, please do not hisitate to call on us. We feel that withheld information of this nature might cause some other family to endure such an experience.

Dear Mr. Roberts:

At the request of Mr. and as per my telephone conversation with you on this date, I will relate the following information, to-wit:

Crosby County Sheriff. Fletcher Stark, called my home on Saturday morning several months ago, asking that I meet him at the jail in Crosbyton, Texas. Upon my arrival I was introduced to Mr. and two other gentlemen from Lorenzo, Texas. They related an incident concerning Dr. Means and Mr. son, This incident has been related to you in a letter from Mr. days later Mr. and some other gentlemen came to my office and reported that they had discovered that other irregular incidents had occurred between Dr. Means and certain boys that he had association with in his boy scout group. They also stated that there had been some type community meeting and Dr. Means had either withdrawn as boy scout leader, or had been dismissed.

Dr. Means was asked to come to my office for conversation concerning these matters. He did come and stated that he was innocent of any wrong doing. He did admit that he had practiced hypnosis upon certain children and groups of children without consent or presence of their parents.

Mr. has asked me to relay to you his and his family's will-ingness to cooperate with you in any way possible concerning this matter, short of placing the child in court for testimony. The child will be available for questioning of an investigatory body of your

association. He also states that other families claim similar experiences and will be willing to give private information concerning this matter.

Gentlemen:

In mid-December, 1970, Dr. R. Ted Means, then Scoutmaster of Troop 399, Lorenzo, Texas, was asked to resign by the Troop Committee because of alleged acts of homosexuality with one or more of the Scouts in the Troop.

Dr. Means, an osteopathic physician, did resign, but did not admit to any part of the allegations.

Because Lorenzo is a small town and because minors were involved, the members of thr Troop Committee chose not to press charges.

We were informed by the Troop Committee Chairman today that Dr. Means has moved to Sedalia, Missouri where he will presumable open a practice. It is our understanding that he moved to that community about August 1, 1971.

I felt that you should be informed in order that you may inform the council serving Sedalia if you so desire.
