SUBJECT: Douglas Hoffelder

1: While Troop 249 was at Camp Famous Eagle, during the week of July 10, 1970, I was approached by Mr. Otto, the Camp Director and my District Executive, and was asked to investigate the subject's activities in Scouting.

2: I had personally observed the subject playing "strip poker" with certain Scouts during the same week of summer camp. Nothing was done at that time except to remind him that this was not acceptable conduct for an adult leader.

3: On another occasion, the subject was witnessed playing cards with some Explorers for money.

4: Mr. Orville Harris, Chief Ranger, had also reported to Don Rall that he had found some obscene literature on a campsite after the subject and some Scouts had departed. I received this information from Mr. Otto and verified it with Mr. Harris.

5: While discussing another matter with one of my older Scouts, he related that he had heard that the subject had homosexual relations with a scout, while a second Scout was present. As a result of this information, I interrogated the two Scouts named and received confirmation of the incident which did not happen during a Scout Function. After promising to protect the identities of the involved Scouts, I received handwritten concerning the incident from the Scouts involved. Typewritten copies of these two statements are attached, with the names of the Scouts deleted. I am retaining the originals of these two statements in a safe place and will not release them without permission of the Scouts signing them, or under Court Order.

6: As a result of these statements, I confronted the subject, who admitted the incident, and requested that he immediately sever all connections with the Scouting movement or any other youth activities. I also suggested that he obtain professional Guidance.

7: At the Scout Skill Show, October 30, 1971, I met the subject and found out that he was now involved with a Scout Troop in Cherokee District.

8: I have also noted that his name appears in the current Merit Badge Counselor lists.

STATEMENT BY SCOUT "A"

Me and B were picked up in front of my house then we rode straight to the Y. We went swimming for an hour. We left the Y and went to Jack in the Box, when we were through eating we went to O'Fallon and Doug started talking about sex then we rode around and B got some beans. We went back to O'Fallon and Doug offered a dollar to us if our penis was over three inches long, then we rode around some more. Then when we went back to O'Fallon, then Doug was talking some more. Then we went riding around, then we went back Doug gave us two dollars if we pulled our pants down below our knees. We went riding all through the "Hill". Then Doug wanted to suck our penis for a dollar, then 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and finally seven and I let at the Electrical Workers then he dropped us off at home. B just went to pulling down his pants.

STATEMENT BY SCOUT "B"

Doug picked us up, A and me at A's house at about 10:30 to eleven to go swimming at the "Y" pool. Nothing happened on the way there. When we got there we went swimming and started back. We stopped at Jack in the Box to get something to eat. After we left, Doug started saying he'd give A 3 dollars if he'd take off his pants. A did it and received the 3 dollars. He asked me the same thing and said he'd tie me down if I didn't. I thought he was kidding. I did it and got 3 dollars. Then Doug asked A if he could suck him. A said no at first then finally said yes and they both tried to talk me into doing it. I didn't do it but Doug did it to A and paid him 7 dollars. They did this on the Electrical Workers lot. Doug then brought us home, and let us both off at A's house and I walked home.

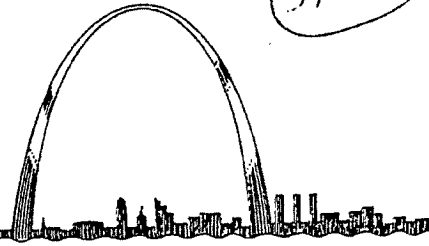
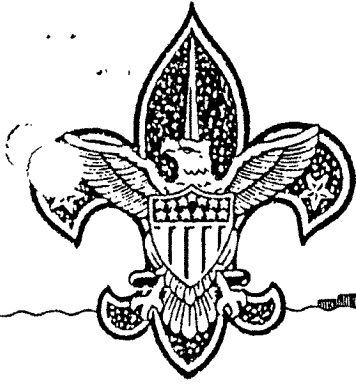
