To whom it may concern:

In reference to a pending confidential file on Richard J. Gauthe, I,

Scoutmaster of Troop 408, Denver Area Council, the Troop
within which Mr. Gauthe was last registered, was contacted to provide
more information as backup material for Mr. Gauthe's statement given to
the Scout Executive of the Denver Area Council.

The facts are as follows:

After Mr. Gauthe had signed his statement to the Denver Area Council, he was summoned to a hearing of evidence for possible military action by Lowry Air Force Base. I, was asked to appear before the hearing to present my information concerning Mr. Gauthe's action.

At the hearing, I informed the hearing board that on three occasions, with three different members of the Troop as reported to me, Mr. Gauthe had taken the liberty of fondling the genitals of these young Scouts while they were asleep in sleeping bags. Two of these occasions occurred on Troop campouts and the third incident occurred when a Scout spent the evening in Military billeting with Mr. Gauthe just prior to a campout. The parents of the Scout who was in Military billeting was the party that caused the incidents to come to light.

My involvement was that of a Scoutmaster who had the responsibility of seeing that the parents of the boys knew what incidents had occurred. It is my understanding that Mr. Gauthe has been released from further military service on a medical discharge as a result of the hearing. Military procedure does not allow for civilians to obtain information on the outcome of such hearings unless they were directly involved. As a result, cannot state the supposed reason for his discharge to be fact
