MEMORANDUM

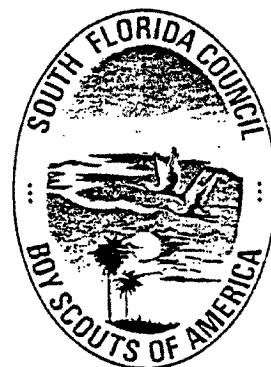

Date: August 31, 1972

In early June, 1972, certain alligations were made by [REDACTED], M. C., of Troop 105, New River District, concerning Charles J. Urig, Jr. Neighborhood Commissioner. The alligations were investigated and found to be based on fact.

On June 21, I discussed the incident with Charles Urig and he admitted that he made homosexual advances to three boy members of Troop 105 while on an outing. He also stated that he had received an undesirable discharge from the United States Navy on the grounds of homosexuality. After further discussion with Mr. Urig he agreed not to register with the South Florida Council, Boy Scouts of America.
