Dear Sir:

Arvid Roswell, Scoutmaster, Troop 39 sponsored by First Lutheran Church, 1005 Oxford Avenue, Eau Claire should be immediately placed in the confidential file.

On the evening of October 28, 1972 Roswell, accompanied by fourteen year old Star Scout [redacted] traveled by car to the troop's campsite near Eau Claire to obtain logs for use at the upcoming Camporee.

According to [redacted] after selecting and loading the wood, Roswell offered to let him drive the car. [redacted] accepted and, while he was driving, Roswell made physical advances.

[redacted] reported the affair to his parents who in turn notified the Scout Executive. When confronted with [redacted] accusations Roswell denied the charges.

The [redacted] boy was again questioned in careful detail and was firm in his original accusation.

Roswell when confronted a second time with the full detail admitted his actions. The admission took place in my presence and that of Peter Lokkesmoe, District Executive.

Roswell was asked for his immediate written resignation in accordance with a plan previously developed with Rev. Maynard Midthun, executive officer of the sponsoring institution, who could not be present.


