JUDGMENT AND ORDER OF PROBATION

, 19 72, came the attorney for the government and the May On this 22nd defendant appeared in person, and by his attorney W. J. Sheridan, Jr. day of

It is Adjuncted that the defendant has been convicted upon his plea of guilty

of the offense of carnel abuse of a child, in violation of

6 Canal Zone Code §543

as charged

and the court having asked the defendant whether he has anything to say why judgment should not be pronounced, and no sufficient cause to the contrary being shown or appearing to the court,

IT Is ADJUDGED that the defendant is guilty as charged and convicted.

It is Abjuncto that the defendant, Ralph John Crimsley, be imprisoned in the penitentiary of the Canai Zone at hard labor for TWO (2) YEARS and pay the costs of this action. It is further

ORDERED char the defendant be given credit for the time spent in jail while awaiting

sentence maich is twenty-eight (28) days. It is further

ORDERED that the execution of said sentence be suspended and the defendent placed on probation pending his good behavior for FIVE (5) YEARS; and on the further conditions that he: 1. not violate any law of the Canal Zone, the Republic of Panama, the United States of America, or any individual State thereof during the term of his probation. 2. Report to the Probation Officer during the term of his probation in the manner that said Officer shall direct, and upon his return to the United States, to a Probation Officer where he shall reside. 3. The defendant shall voluntarily submit to a program of competent psychiatric treatment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that during the period of probation the defendant shall demean himself as a law-abiding, orderly, industrious citizen and observe such conditions of probation as the probation officer may prescibe. Otherwise the defendant may be brought before the court for a violation of the court's orders.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk deliver two certified copies of this judgment and order to the probation officer of this court, one of which shall be delivered to the defendant by the probation officer.
