Iate in May 1972 District Executive Arthur Koeppel was contacted by William Dickinson, Institutional Representative of Church of the Cross Roads Troop 6, Orange. An incident was reported involving Assistant Scoutmaster A. John Gooding and Scout

At a troop meeting and "rap" session in May after the Scouts had told what good things they had done in Scouting, Gooding - over the objection of Scoutmaster James Taylor - insusted that the boys also tell what they thought was good or bad about him. Included in the replies was the statement by young that Gooding was a "queer".

Efforts were made at once to get to apologize. He refused. Messrs. Taylor, Gooding, and Rev. Langston Miles went to the boy's home to discuss this with the boy and his mother.

After the discussion, Gooding was asked to no longer associate with the troop. He has not. His registration card - received with the charter renewal - has been withheld by this council.

The minister of the church, Rev. Joseph Thomasberger, is also aware of the problem.

At the close of the discussion, Gooding himself stated that the National Council would have to be notified.

Enclosed are letter signed by the scout and written by his mother along with a letter from Rev. Langston Miles.
