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While acting as Scoutmaster of Troop 55, on 6/5/73 (alone) and on 6/15/73 (before you and Mr. Jim Smith as witnesses), I heard the following information from the following information of Troop 55; which information I believe to be true.

Assistant Scoutmaster Lawrence Paul Kidd during September 1972 in his dormitory room at Asbury College did commit a homosexual act of masterbation and did attempt an oral homosexual act upon the person of the above-named Scout, age 14. During the Fall quarter (September thru November) of 1972, the Scout was given rides from school five miles distant but often was taken to the dorm where he rebuffed repeated "passes" and expressed his desire to go home. An approach was attempted on a Scout campout on the Gayheart farm, Handy's Bend Road, Jessamine County, on the night of 12/8/72. In February 1973, in the Scout's home, the last attempt to commit a homosexual act was again rebuffed by the Scout.

On 6/20/73 the Scout was persuaded to report this information to his father. Afterwards I talked with the father and he is willing to join me in testimony if absolutely necessary. (This is a small community and the Scout's identity is so far known only to us.)

A description and other information concerning Lawrence Kidd is enclosed.

Thank you for your attention to this situation.

The following statement oncerns the remarks made boy scout of Troop 55, Wilmore, Ky, about the alleged homosexuality of the assistant scout master, raul Lawrence (Lar) Kidd, and alleged homosexual acts performed on the boy by the ASM Kidd. The statement was given by the boy on June 15, 1973 at 11:45 AM, in a room of one of the buildings at Asbury College, wilmore, Ky., to me in the presence of Mr. Harland Lutz, ADC for Jessamine County, and of Mr. Ed Underwood, Dimtrict Executive for the Thoroughbred District, Bluegrass council, Boy Scouts of America.

I am transcribing the statement of the boy from notes that I made at the meeting, and from dates given to me at a later date by Mr. Lutz through MRr. Underwood. Therefore, I can say that the remarks on this paper are true and accurate to the best of my knowledge insofar as they were the statements made by the boy,

said that he was concerned about these activities and that his part in them was troubling him considerably, therefore he was bringing it out into the open. He also implied that he was concerned about being able to help the ASM Kidd. (He said that Kidd also liked girls.) He was a very troubled boy. He wanted to bring these activities to a halt, but found it difficult to do this because he could not avoid Mr. Kidd.

We asked the boy to tell us just exactly what kind of acts were performed and to give us dates if possible.

The first occurence was in September, 1972. The boy could not be sure of the exact day, but said that it was about two weeks after Mr. Kidd moved into Wessley Hall at the college. The act took place in the room of Mr. Kidd at the dormitory, Wessley Hall. He said that Mr. Kidd performed masturbation on him and then attempted an oral act on the boy (he tried to suck the boy's penis) which the boy said that he resisted.

Another occurence was during a camping trip at the W.C. Gayheart farm on the Handy's Bend Rd. on December 8, 1972. Mr. Kidd made passes at the boy and performed similar acts on him as before. He also attempted some other act on the boy which he did not explain.

The last time was in February, 1973, at the boy's home. Mr. Kidd made passes at the boy but the boy apparently resisted him at this time.

The boy was not too clear on whether or not other scouts were involved, but implied that there were a couple of other boys involved with this man. It should be said that Mr. Kidd was involved with the youth in his capacity as a music teacher, so it would be difficult to guess how many boys he had victimized. Apparently, his position as music teacher gave him frequent contacts with and in fact, told us that he often accepted rides home from Mr. Kidd. He implied that it was on a couple of these occassions that the homosexual acts occured.

This concludes my recollections of the testimony of made on June 15, 1973. This statement is true and accurate to the best of my knowledge.
