

# Raymond Andrew Hampton

I have been asked to draw to your attention the above-named who has been suspended from membership of this Association.

Hampton was born on the 26th August 1949 and is at present serving with the British forces in Western Europe.

He has admitted to taking drugs and is at present under medical treatment in a military hospital. He has admitted to homosexual practice and the services Investigation Branch in the course of a search of his quarters for drugs found a mass of pornographic and homosexual material.

It is understood that prior to his Scout service with our Association hewas concerned with Scouting with the Boy Scouts of America. It is felt likely that following any legal action and military discipline, he will return to the United States of America and no doubt you will wish to have this advice on record should he make any contact with your Association.
