

We are recommending that Samuel (Robert) Ferguson be placed in the confidential file.

This case did not make the newspapers, but improper sexual molestation did take place with three boys, including covert actions at Mr. Ferguson's home. In fact, Mr. Ferguson admitted to the parents and to the committee this deviant behavior with boys in his troop.

Our investigation of this case leads us to the conclusion that he must be placed in the confidential file.
