Followup visit to Joel Michael Farley completed Saturday, February 9, 1973 by David Borchard, District Executive and LaVerne Wells, District Commissioner at his place of business, Hi-Way Transport, 820 Black Oak Ridge Rd., Wayne, N.J.

- 1. Stated they were on business. Letter read to him informing him that 3.S.A. chose not to accept his registration as an adult leader. He was also informed that this information would not be shared with anyone. They made no accusations and handed the letter to J.M. Farley.
- 2. Mr. Farley stated that his intentions were good and that his endeavors in Scouting had always been energetic and that he was interested in helping boys. He asked that his Doctor, Harry K. Panjwani, M.D.P.A., 66 Glen Ave., Glen Rock, N.J. 07452 be contacted. (This has been done and the Doctor is writing a statement that he will forward.)
- 3. Mr. Farley was requested to surrender his Merit Badge Counselor registration card and he willingly complied. He stated that he meant to take action against the Detective who supplied Mr. Borchard with the information. He said he felt no grudge or malice against Mr. Borchard and that he understood the concern of the B.S.A. in cases such as this. He was asked to refer any boys halfway through a Merit Badge subject to another Counselor or to the Council Service Center. He agreed to stop all Scouting activities at this time.

This morning came into the garage around 6:30 A.M. 12/20/72 with her nephew mentioned he wanted to see the High School we go to where 60 buses go (Ramapo High School, Franklin Lakes.) That's the school I was assigned to drive for this morning. I offered to take him with me, so he could see the school. His aunt said it would be 0.Ka/t about 7:00 A.M. we left the garage and I did the bus route and took him with me to the High School. At 7:33 A.M. we left Ramapo and went on the bus route for Indian Hills, Oakland. I finished that route at 7:55 A.M. and went to the Ramapo Wigwam Coffee Shop and had coffee. We left there at 8:30 A.M.

We returned to the garage at 9:15 A.M.. We spent some time in the garage and met his aunt (), Milton Road, Oak Ridge. We had coffee, and he, played a couple games of checkers with a Joe Morgan.

I took with me at around 10:00 A.M. to my place at Camp Savio to pick up some rock salt and a chess game. On the way up, he was sitting very quietly and I asked him what he was quiet about. He said, "Nothing much." To break the ice I said, have you got any girl friends? He said he did have one down in Florida and a couple his cousin was going to fit him up with. I asked him how he makes out with his girl friends. He said he had gotten a piece about 10 times. I then asked him, arentt you afraid you'll knock them up? He wasn't worried, but his brother had knocked up a couple. It was during this time that I opened my fly and exposed myself and told him if you are this big you have nothing to worry about. He said he was big enough. We drove up to Camp Savio and we went un. After we got in the house, I started to touch him to see if he would get excited. He was getting nervous and said he was getting sick. He asked me for a couple of aspirin and I gave him some. I felt his forehead to see if he had a temperature. He went into the bathroom and came back out. I told him to sit down and I would find this book (Sex and everything you wanted to know about sex). He said he wanted to go for a walk and asked if he could take the dog.

Voluntary statement of JOEL MICHAEL FARLEY continued

I told him he could, and he left the house with the dog and I followed behind with the leash. I put the leash on the dog and we walked up toward the center of the camp. I told him I was going into the cabin to get the chess set, and when I came back he was out of sight.

I went back down to the house and located the book and went back out to call for him, and the dog came back. I then went in my car looking for him.
