



Dear Mr. Grable:

The Ouachita Area Council has information related to a volunteer Scouter - Mr. Sam C. Otts - currently registered as Assistant Scoutmaster of Troop 16. This is his primary registration, he is also registered as Scoutmaster of Troop 14 and Webelos Leader of Pack 13 in Hot Springs, Arkansas.

Due to the implications of this man's activities and conduct during the last two weeks, I am asking you to place him on the confidential list where he will never again be eligible to serve in any capacity whatsoever in Scouting.

Sam C. Otts is 50 years old, white-haired, about 6'7" in height, wears a white mustache. He is slow and deliberate in his speech, he is well-educated and looks older than he is (a photo is enclosed). He has an outstanding knowledge of all three programs of Scouting.

Listed below are statements that were made by the parents of Webelos Scouts in a group meeting and statements that were made by Mr. Otts when Council President John Thomas and Scout Executive Ralph Young met with him on Wednesday, August 13.

- .. On Tuesday afternoon, August 12, approximately 5:45 p.m., the Scout Executive received a phone call at his home from the Office Manager Frankie Herron, informing him that volunteer in Cub Scouting) was in the office and needed to talk with him. Young stated he would return immediately to the office.
- distraught mother who said there were some indications that her son's Webelos Leader Mr. Otts, had not conducted himself in the way she thought he should on a camping trip with her son and another Webelos then called to ask her to come and meet with Young.
- came and reported to Mr. Young that Mr. Otts had taken her son, and and camping on Thursday, August 7. She said when they were ready for bed that Mr. Otts suggested that since it was so hot that they all would be more comfortable to sleep without any clothes on.

 also said that when she related to that the boys
and Mr. Otts had slept nude that told her she had received an
anonymous phone call at her office (from an older man) who asked her didn't
her son camp out with Mr. Otts, she told him yes he had. He said to her
"Don't you know Mr. Otts is a homosexual?" she said certainly not. That's
when told she knew someone who was very active in
Scouting and that she was going to go talk to her. That's when

 After related this to make a Mr. Young and
Mr. Young asked her to call and see if she would come to the
Scout Service Center to meet with the group. did call and
came to the office approximately 30 minutes later.

- .. Mr. Young asked them to tell him what they know about the situation.
- They confirmed the anonymous phone call and that they had talked with their son said she asked her son had they slept in the nude and he answered yes, we all did. She asked him who had suggested they do this and he replied, Mr. Otts. She asked him if he had touched him and he said yes; how, he tickled my feet and ribs; sakedhis son did he touch you anywhere else yes, on my butt. saked her son if Mr. Otts touched his penis, said yes. said yes. saked his son, did he kiss you?
- then asked if the BSA had ever had any allegations in the past in regard to Mr. Otts, Young stated no not in the 4 years he had beenin Ouachita Area Council. He then asked Mr Young how long Mr. Otts had been in Scouting -approximately 5 years in this council, but has a previous Scouting background in Alabama and Georgia.
- .. indicated that another Webelos had also been involved in a separate incidence. The boy's mother was contacted and she had a meeting with the Scout Executive at 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday.
- .. She stated that her son, told her yes Mr. Otts had done the same things to him.

After the Scout Executive contacted the Council President early Wednesday morning, the arranged a meeting with Mr. Otts for 9:30 p.m. that evening at the Scout Service Center.

The Scout Executive reviewed all the accusations that had been made by the families from his notes of the meetings and asked Mr. Otts the following questions (with Mr. Otts replies):

Did you go camping with these boys - yes
Did the three of you sleep in the nude - yes
Did you put your hands on these boys' bodies - yes
Where - in the armpits and ribs
Did you put your hand on their privates - yes
Have you ever been involved as a homosexual - no, I have not
Have you ever been accused by parents like this before - yes and no
Why did you do all this - I don't know, I guess I've been very foolish.
Did you kiss the boy - yes
Where did you kiss the boy - on the lips

Mr. Otts is employed by the Salvation Army, the Scout baccutive had tried to contact Maj. William L. Schmieder, local corps commander on Tuesday evening and was told he was on vacation until September 2. Young asked Otts for a number where the Major could be reached. Otts answered yes he has a number, but I'm not supposed to give it out. I will call him tomorrow and talk to him and ask him to call you.

Young at this time expressed his grave disappointment to Otts and told him as of tonight he was no longer eligible to serve in Scouting and that his name would be removed from all Scouting activities. Young told him he was no longer to attend any Scouting functions or have any contact with the Scouts or Scouting Units.

Otts stated that Troop 16 was having a family campout this weekend at Brady Mountain Lodge. He said since he had made the arrangements could he still go with them. Young told him under no circumstances was he to go or participate in this event or any other event whatsoever.

This instruction was given to Mr. Otts in the presence of Council President John A. Thomas.



Please pull the registration of Sam Carottsy Scoutnester of Troop 37 and of Post=2037, Berry Academy; Mr. Berry; Gar -- 30149.

Please put him in the confidential file not to be registered in Scouting again -Reason - homosexual behavior.

Otts had been employed as a teacher and dormitory proctor at Berry Academy, a boarding school. He was dismissed from the employment of the school and relieved of his duties as Scoutmaster and Explorer Advisor by the Headmaster, for homosexual involvement with the young son of another faculty member.

Date of the incident, January 28, 1977.

Our relationship with the school continues to be excellent and replacement leadership for the units has been secured. The headmaster is a member of the council executive board.

Otts has been in this area about four or five years. He is a 1975 graduate of Berry College. He has had a close association with the Salvation Army in Dalton, Ga. His social security number Is , he was born 1178/30, he is 76'6" tall, weighs about 245 lbs., has white hair and white mustaches He has worked on camp staff, been to Wood Badge. Would probably seek work in schools, camps, and textile mills. Possible Scouting affiliation in the past is in Nashville, Tenn. council.

He says he was borngin Missouri and has lived in or been in just about every section of the country. معتمل د

Sam Otts was employed by Berry Academy for two and one-half years, June, 1974, through January, 1977. During the same period he was Scoutmaster for Troop 37 and worked during the summer as a part of the staff at Camp Sidney Dew. Mr. Otts was head of our boys dormitory and lived in an apartment in the dormitory. On January 28, 1977, Mr. Otts was working with the eleven year old son of one of Berry's teachers on a scout project, although the boy was not a member of Sam's troop. Sam fondled the boy's penis in a way to cause the boy to masturbate. Mr. Otts was dismissed from employment with Berry, and a stipulation of his severance was that he use some proffered money from Berry to seek professional counseling regarding his homosexual tendencies.

Mr. Otts is a man of many great strengths, and one who contributed significantly to The Berry Schools. If I may be of further assistance in matters concerning Mr. Otts, I will be pleased to do so.
