Dear Mr. Parkinson,

This is to advise that Staff Sergeant Walter J. Mulnix, recently associated with the scouting program at RAF Lakenheath, England, has been discharged from the service following his admission that he had been involved in repeated and varied sexual offenses with approximately twenty boys between the ages of 9 and 13 years. These offenses occurred over an extended period of time, and in most instances took place during overnight Boy Scout camping trips.

The sole purpose of this letter is to request that immediate action be taken through appropriate BSA channels to insure that this individual is never permitted to have any further association with, or allowed to participate in, scouting programs of any nature. In addition, if the BSA has an established procedure for alerting other organizations, such as the YMCA, Big Brothers, and others, such action would appear appropriate.

The information contained herein should not be released publicly, nor used for any purpose other than as stated above.

I have made repeated efforts to get additional information on Walter J. Mulnix and have gotten nothing.

All I know was that he was discharged from the Air Force because the evidence seemed to indicate that he had been involved in some sexual deviation involving Scouts. The parents elected not to press charges and plans for a court marshall were dropped.

It hardly makes a tight case against him but I hope he never gets back in Scouting.
