



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- 1) No, he did not tender a resignation, nor did he respond to suggestions to meet with the Church leaders. Instead, he just "dropped out" of communications when "exposed" and was reported to have re-acted in a nasty negative manner when approached about his relationship to Scouting subsequently.
- 2) In regards to other information, it was reported that he telephoned pretending to be a patent, and had the boy released early from school where he picked him up. The parents later found out.
- 3) A Scout in Troop reported homosexual assault on himself from approximately one year before the current incident in question. The boy went to pastor, who decided that the bey was unbalanced he had received some counselling. The boy never changed his story of assault and recently, the priest relected that he may have been in error.
- 4) As far as character in general, it was reported that was fired from his last job as a bartender by the Committee Chairman, who learned this from the owner, a personal friend.
- 5) There are no written or sworn satatements, except that same could be obtained from the who's son was fed intoxicants in a partment, when he was to have taken the boys shopping from a camp-out. Further, the man's military service record with the U.S. Army could be searched as there is question about the type of discharge he may possess.

Perhaps the Boy Scouts of America could benefit from an application with additional information required, such as military service and arrest information.
