

## MEMORANDUM

Ron:

At your request I write this account of my knowledge regarding the homosexuality charges raised against one [redacted] of the above mentioned Troop.

My association with [redacted] lasted only about six months during which I became aware of several acts of homosexuality and abnormal conductivity on his part with several boys in the troop. Until I was personally approached [redacted] had no real evidence that such activity was actually going on aside from numerous comments from boys in the troop.

After being approached, I proceeded to observe [redacted] activities somewhat closer and noticed that he made many efforts to be alone with boys from the Troop.

Having had my concerns varified I contacted the District Chairman, [redacted] and together he and I talked to [redacted] and convinced him that he should resign his post as Scoutmaster of [redacted] and have no contact with any members of the troop at any future date. Having agreed to this arrangement Mr. Brehaut and myself left and proceeded to make arrangements to fill [redacted] position as Scoutmaster of [redacted] 8.

For about one year [redacted] bided by our verbal agreement however, last June he approached the Troop committee stating that he desired to return to work with the Troop. Upon hearing of this situation I contact the Committee Chairman, Mr. [redacted] and informed him of [redacted] past "performance" with the Troop and felt that

any chance of [redacted] returning to the Troop were squelched. This was not the case however. The full committee voted to allow [redacted] to return in the capacity of an Assistant Scoutmaster and at the same time made the other assistants and the Scoutmaster aware of past problems.

During the summer months that ensued much commotion arose over [redacted]'s return and in August of this year a parents group, separate from the parents committee got together and demanded that the committee reverse its' decision to allow [redacted] to return at which time the committee complied.

I have agreed to write this letter, upon your request, because I do not feel that Mr. [redacted] should be permitted to apply or act in any capacity with the Scouting program because of his inability to control this problem with homosexual behavior.

Should any further questioning or information be required to achieve this end please feel free to call me at any time.
