To date, there have been no police reports and consequently no arrest has been made. Our understanding is that there will be no charges pressed.

Marlin Bates reviewed the situation with the Bishopt for Mr. McKinney's Latter Day Saints Ward and the Bishop is now working with Mr. McKinney.

The Bishop did not indicate that he had any knowledge of a previous problem.

When Marlin Bates met with Mr. McKinney to refund his registration fee, Mr. McKinney stated only that he knew he had a problem and was meeting with his Bishop on it.

If I get additional information, I will forward it on to you.
