The salary for the above period of time is \$1,000.00 and the above named person will be (Name of Position) Camp Director during the employment period. The Council will provide room and board. As stated above your salary will start on the day you report for work. All members are expected to arrive the opening day of Staff Week and stay until August 30, 1973. You will not be paid for any days of work missed, except your day off, from the opening date of Staff Week until the closing date of this contract.

(From last of camp season to 8/31, will serve as Council Representative with Camp Lessees)
The York-Adams Area Council reserves the right to revoke this employment contract if the conduct of the staff member in any way interferes with the over-all operation of this summer camp program. The Staff member may be released from this contract should the camp attendance be such as not to warrant his services for all or part of the summer camping season and without pay for this released period.

It is our mutual understanding that:

1. You will live on the camp property in such place as designated by the Camp Director.
2. You will be given one day (24 hours) off each week as designated by the Camp Director.
3. You will be expected to wear the official Scout or Explorer uniform at all times when on duty. (Exception at Waterfront)
4. Your duties will be assigned by the Camp Director, but may be changed if necessary, and you will be expected to carry out all duties as directed by the Camp Director. (Example: You may be assigned to assist in commissary or cleaning duties.)
5. You must have a physical examination within 30 days of coming to camp.
6. Staff members under 18 years of age are not allowed to smoke while at camp unless they bring written permission from their parents. Staff members are not allowed to smoke while on duty.

We have read the above employment contract and agree to all points in it.

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the letter December 23, 1974.

On December 26, 1974 I had a meeting with Greg Lambert in my office as we had Summer Camp Staff Interviews scheduled for Dec. 27. I was instructed by [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] to present Greg a copy of the letter.

I gave Greg the copy of the letter, he did not have his notes but stated that he felt that we to find out corner or later. He then proceeded to read a list of names of persons he had been involved with during 1973 and 1974. This list is in his own handwriting - he freely offered to provide the names. At no time did I pressure him to discuss it.

This meeting between Greg and I was extremely long and during this time he expressed much concern. He stated that no adult had ever been involved. He also stated that he had wondered how long it would be before we were aware of the situation.

Greg was an intelligent person and was very cooperative.

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and we had a fine group of men and staff. He was not involved with any staff during 1974 but was in 1975.

It is important to note that we did get some help - at the hospital this winter. There is a fine young man.

The name of the young man, whose father gave us the written statement, does not appear on any of the papers.

In summary, after presenting the letter to Greg, he read it and stated to me that he was resigning as Group Director. He then asked me what he would need to resign from every position he holds in Scouting. He agreed.

Further I requested his resignation as Group Director in writing on January 17, 1975. He promised to send this immediately to us. On Monday Jan. 20, [redacted]

Having a call from [redacted], Scout Executive Valley Forge Council advising that Greg had not resigned from his several Scout positions in Valley Forge Council, and in fact being at a Scout Roundtable during the week of January 13th. They requested Greg's resignations no later than January 30, 1975.

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At 5:15 PM on January 20th I called
Brea advising him that I had not received
his written resignation. He promised to
mail it to me on Monday evening.

I also informed him that he had to
submit to Valley Forge Council, written
resignations before January 30th.

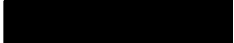

During the week of July 7 - 13, 1974 my two sons, age 11 and 13, attended Camp Tuckahoe. The younger son advanced through the usual achievements for his age. The older son did not accomplish a single merit badge. We accosted our son about this and did not receive a satisfactory answer. Assuming him to be in a rebellious stage of development or, lazy, we did not pursue the matter. Later, during an intimate conversation some weeks afterward, he revealed that he had had a homosexual experience. Realizing that this sometimes occurs between boys at this age we were not overly alarmed until he revealed that it was not another boy but the Camp Director, Mr. Greg Eisenhart. This is his summary of the situation. Late one night a group of scouts were assembled in a tent for the usual fun & joking of camping. Suddenly the tent flap was pulled open and there stood the Camp Director. The boys were intrigued at the ability of the director to stalk silently into the camp site. The director then asked if any boys would like to learn to stalk at night. My son volunteered with enthusiasm. After wandering about the woods for some time, the director took him to the chapel and enticed my son into allowing him (the director) to fondle his genitals. Realizing the error in judgment, my son protested and ran terrified, back to his camp site. The next day the director asked him if he would like to learn more about stalking in the daylight. My son said that he most certainly did NOT. The conversation was overheard by a fellow scout in Troop 104 who volunteered to learn this stalking game. (About a month ago, the boy asked our son what had happened to him during his stalking experience. My son said that nothing had

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happened, being too ashamed of the experience. Then the boy embarrassingly admitted to my son that when the director took him on the adventure, behind the doctor's office, that he was fondled about the genitals to the point of ejaculation.

I do not wish to belabour the issue but I would raise a few questions.

- 1) If this incidence occurred to two boys in one troop, how many more boys were taken advantage of, during the entire camping season?
- 2) Should the directorship of Camp Tuckahoe, where the scouting experience influences a boy's life, be entrusted to this type of individual?
- 3) Should not Mr. Eisenhart be confronted with the issue, or at least be made aware that the professional staff of the York-Adams Area has been alerted to the problem?

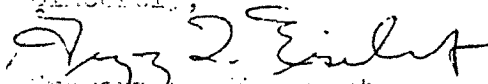
Dear Mr. Frank,

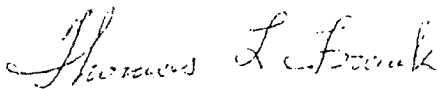
