"A" Catholic priest and a Boy Scout troop leader were arrested Sunday after the parents of a 9 - year - old complained that their son L. Davis, 42, of 16909 E. had been molested, sheriff's deputies reported.

The Rev. Harry R. Morgan, 60, of 14231 Yerba Buena, pastor of the Church of the Ascension, and Donald Pueblo, a scout master and apprentice plumber, were

booked into Maricopa County Jail for investigation of child molesting.

Detective Robert Wojtaszek said booking records allege Father Morgan molested the 9-year-old and that Davis

molested the same boy in a separate incident and also molested six other youngsters.

The victims ranged from 8. to 14 years old, Wojtaszek said, and the molestations all took place in the Fountain Hills community.

He said the molestations apparently began last October, but parents of the victimized boys have been reluctant to report the incidents.

"We may find more victims ... we're not certain," Wojtaszek said. "It's difficult to find victims because people. are a little hesitant to report (the molestations).

Sunday's arrest came after the 'mother of the 9-year-old called deputies. Detective Alan

Weiss, who interviewed the woman, was told of several other incidents of sexual . molestations and tight-lipped families.

Interviews with other families led to the arrest of Davis, Wojtaszek sald.

Davis, who has worked in the Fountain-Hills communi-

ty for the past three lives with his 18-year-old daughter. He is separated from his wife, Wojtaszek said, and has been active in Boy Scout work
