Unless we receive the above requested material, it will be difficult to keep this man's name on the Confidential File.



Gentlemen:

We wish to place the name of RICHARD L. ROBINSON in your confidential file. Mr. Robinson is formerly the Scoutmaster of Troop 238 in Elkton, Maryland. He resigned his position as Scoutmaster last fall when several parents brought charges against him for molesting their boys in connection with Scouting activities.

Mr. Robinson has continued to deny these allegations even though the parents have brought suit against him. The case has gone to court and in late November he was convicted of these charges.

He has never been sentenced in this case. He asked for another trial because his lawyer never accepted any of the witnesses that were there on his behalf or let him speak at the trial. Mr. Robinson feels that his rights were violated and he deserves a new trial. His lawyer has requested another trial and at this moment it is pending, thus the reason for no sentencing.

We are keeping abreast of the matter. I talked with Mr. Robinson yesterday who asked if he could work with adults in Scouting. I told him that he shouldn't work with anyone in Scouting until he officially receives a clean bill by the courts.

If you will please send me the proper forms, I will be very happy to fill them out for your records.
