RE: Homosexual Activity of Kim Allen Overlin

Dear Sir:

In my private capacity I have learned Army Specialist (Chaplain's Assistant) Kim Allen Overlin is being processed by the U.S. Army for an undesirable discharge because of homosexual activity with Boy Scouts under his control. Overlin made homosexual advances to or actually molested at least five boys in Boy Scout Troops 154 and 155 at Fort Leonard Wood (Ozark Council). Overlin has held several positions in scouting in this area. He has been Scoutmaster of Troop 154 and he has a possibly self-imposed title of Assistant Round Table Commissioner for the Ozark Council's Big Piney District Committee. He also is a Wood Badge Bead Holder.

Overlin's receipt of an undesirable discharge will result in his having a federal criminal record. This record will become a part of the FBI crime files. However, due to the severe and sometimes unreasonable restrictions of the Privacy Act, information regarding the issuance of an undesirable discharge will be available only to law enforcement agencies, and not to private or public organizations. Information regarding the reason for the discharge, i.e., homosexuality, may possibly not be given out even to a law enforcement agency, unless the agency is federal.

Overlin's next Army duty station was to have been in the Bavarian Section of Germany, where he had plans to work with a Boy Scout Troop. He may well pursue these plans as a civilian since he has stated that his parents are stationed in Germany.

It is my intent that this information will irrevocably bar Overlin from any future Boy Scout Activity anywhere in the United States and in the Trans-Pacific and Trans-Atlantic Conferences.

I do not write this letter in an official capacity associated with the U.S. Army or as Committee Chairman of Troop 155; I write this letter as a concerned parent of two boys in scouting, and on behalf of all boys everywhere in scouting.

Information regarding Overlin's activity has been furnished to the Executive Director of the Ozark Council.

I would appreciate your confirmation that Overlin will be permanently barred from any association with the Boy Scouts of America.

However, on 23 July 1976, Mr. Overlin was discharged from the Army. The Privacy Act of 1974 and Army Regulation 340-21 prohibit me from disclosing the reason or type of discharge received by Mr. Overlin, unless Mr. Overlin gives his written consent.
