Dear Mr. Hurst:

We have received notification from the National Council of the Boy Scouts of America that the Boy Scouts of America is unwilling to register you in any position in Scouting because the Boy Scouts of America has received information that indicates that you fail to meet standards of leadership of our organization. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relationships that you may have now with the Boy Scouts of America.

You should understand that the Boy Scouts of America lender-ship registration is a privilege that is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. The Boy Scouts of America reserves the right to refuse registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of leadership which the Boy Scouts of America seeks to provide for American youth. Please also understand that this decision and the reasons for it will be maintained as confidential.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, or if you feel that there has been a mistake, please write to me and send a complete statement covering your adult years, including addresses and dates, occupations and dates, and names of spouses and/or children. I will forward this to the Director of Registration and Statistical Service of the Boy Scouts of America for further review and action.

You should further understand that there is a review procedure in such situations. If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me supporting your claim that your registration as a Boy Scouts of America lender should be granted.

STATEMENT

CONFIDENTIAL

On the night of 8 October 1976, during our District Camporee, I was sleeping in a tent with David Hurst, our Troop Commissioner. Mr. Hurst suggested we spread our separate sleeping bags out unzipped and sleep on top of them under a blanket. Later during the night he tried to touch me below the waist, I didn't say anything but rolled over away from him. He made a number of more attempts during the night and I didn't get much sleep. Nothing was said about this between us as I was embarrassed. The next afternoon I was tired and went into the tent to nap. Mr. Hurst came in and tried to touch me as he had done the night before. I got up and left the tent.

I told my parents about it that evening when they came out for the campfire and my father told Mr. Sullivan, the District Executive.
