In response to your request for a Police Record and a more detailed letter concerning the facts, I would like to inform you that there will not be a Police Record in this case. The incident was a disclosure from Mr. Tebbs wife, to the Pastor of the church in which rr. Tebbs is a member, Pastor of the Mt. Lebanon Christian Church; Cedar Blvd. at Hollycrest Drive; Pittsburgh, Pa. 15228.

After a lengthy meeting with Pastor and myself, a decision was made to confront Mr. Tebbs by Pastor which Pastor did follow through with. Tebbs confessed to Pastor and agreed mutually Mr. Tebbs would leave Scouting.

I am hoping that this will be enough evidence for you and that this is sufficient information to complete the case.



Dear Mr. Spronz:

This letter comes in reference to Mr. Albert Tebbs, about whom we had conversation. After admitting sexual activities which had been previous in the experience of Mr. Tebbs, and according to our conversation, I have asked Mr. Tebbs to terminate his activities with our scouting program.

Therefore, I suggest that he be placed on an inactive list, subsequent to his agreement to seek psychological help with this problem. If, according to the psychologist or psychiatrist, he could assume leadership in the scouting program again; then I would assume you would re-instate him accordingly. Until then I agree with you that he should not participate.

If there is anything we can do to enable Mr. Tebbs to function in a more emotionally healthy way, I am also certain that you will want to help in every way. Since Scouting is concerned with the total person, I enter with you in any help we can render to him.



P.S. - Mr. Tebbs was very open and honest with me. There was no indication in his conversation regarding any of the boys in our troop, since his coming with us in October 1974.
