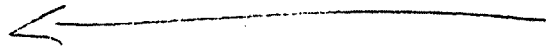

STATEMENT

MR CLAUDE MACEMORE WHO DID LIVE AT 245 HILLCREST DRIVE, ELKIN, N.C. 28621 AND WAS A MEMBER OF THE OLD HICKORY COUNCIL HAS BEEN FOUND TO BE A HOMOSEXUAL. HE WAS SCOUTMASTER OF TROOP 658 AND LATER WORKED WITH TROOP 686. HE MOVED FROM THIS AREA TO COLUMBIA S.C. ABOUT SIX MONTHS AGO HE RETURNED TO THIS AREA FOR ONE WEEK THIS SUMMER TO TAKE TROOP 686 TO SUMMER CAMP. ON TUESDAY JULY 2, 1974 WHILE HE WAS AT CAMP RAVEN KNOB TWO STAFF MEMBERS INFORMED ME OF MR MACEMORE'S PRIOR INVOLVEMENT WITH YOUNG BOYS PRIOR TO HIS DEPARTURE ABOUT SIX MONTHS AGO. I CONTACTED THE SCOUTMASTER OF T 686 AND HAD HIM REPORT TO CAMP. WE THEN CONFRONTED MR MACEMORE WITH THE ACCUSATION. AT FIRST HE DENIED THE CHARGE AND WANTED TO KNOW WHO MADE THEM. I INFORMED MR MACEMORE THAT IF IT WAS TRUE I WOULD PREFER NOT TO INVOLVE THE BOYS BUT IF IT WAS FALSE WE WOULD GET ALL CONCERNED TOGETHER AND SEE WHO WAS TELLING THE TRUTH. AFTER THINKING IT OVER MR MACEMORE SAID IT WOULD BE BEST FOR ALL IF HE JUST DEPARTED. THERE IS NO EVIDENCE TO INDICATE THAT THE BOYS HAD ANY THING TO GAIN BY INFORMING ME OF MR MACEMORE AND WHILE MR MACEMORE NEVER CAME OUT AND SAID THAT HE WAS A HOMOSEXUAL HIS ACTIONS AND WEAK DENIAL STRONGLY INDICATE THAT HE IS.
