#### March 24, 1981 - 3:30 pm

'led Paul Holdeman. Holdeman said would sign a statement but buld prefer not to have his signature as the sole one on it. Holdeman is going to contact three to five other Explorers that knew of or had been approached sexually to see if they would sign a joint statement. Holdeman was to return to me when the signatures had been secured.

#### March 26, 1981 - 4:45 pm

Called Paul Holdeman regarding signed statements by Explorers. He informed me he did not have the signed statement as yet and felt we should confront Harry Howard without the statement as he understood the post was planning activities for the summer and Harry should be relieved before plans were completely finalized. I volunteered to set up the appointment with Rev. Mitchell, Harry Howard, Paul Holdeman and myself.

#### March 31, 1981 - 2:50 pm

Meeting with Harry Howard, Rev. Don Mitchell, Bill Kaufman, Paul Holdeman and myself, Bob Gentry. Paul Holdeman opened the conversation by confronting Harry Howard with the allegations, but mentioning no specific names of Explorers. Harry made no attempt to deny, but seemed to stall for time. Harry wanted to know what we wanted him to do. Rev. Mitchell and I asked him to resign from Scouting. Harry, in a lenghtly conversation, explained he had scheduled antique shows for April 3 and 4 in Nebraska and needed to go to them, intenting to take Explorers with him. I told him that he may not take Explorers with him or act in any capacity an advisor on this trip. Harry agreed. Harry was asked to resign again by

an advisor on this trip. Harry agreed. Harry was asked to resign again by Lev. Mitchell on behalf of the church. He explained that he would not discuss the matter with anyone and if Harry signed a letter of resignation, he would not consider it a confession. He was to talk it over with his wife and let Rev. Mitchell know by 3:00 pm on April 1, 1981. Rev. Mitchell was to call Bill Kaufman, Paul Holdeman and myself when he received or did not receive word from Harry. Paul Holdeman volunteered to set up a meeting with Harry Howard and the Explorer who had the alleged sexual contact so that Harry could discuss the matter and possibly clear his name of any wrongdoing. Harry declined the offer and the offer of any personal or pastoral-type counseling from Rev. Mitchell. The meeting adjourned at 3:45 pm and as Harry left the room, his last words quickly spoken over his shoulder were, "I'm sorry", and then he left.

## April 1, 1981 - 3:00 pm

I checked with Rev. Mitchell to see if Harry Howard had delivered a letter of resignation by 3:00 pm. Harry had indeed and that letter is attached. On the evening of March 31, Harry and his wife called Rev. Mitchell to discuss the matter a little further. Mrs. Howard wanted to have a meeting with the boy to clear up the allegations made against Harry. Harry denied the offer of the meeting and said he couldn't handle the emotional strain. Rev. Mitchell informed me that the superintendent of schools had called him to see if there was any need for the schools to follow up in any official act. Rev. Mitchell said there was no substantial evidence to follow through on, so no follow up was necessary. However, it was recommended that Harry not be put in any situation where he will be in a one-on-one ituation with young people. End of conversation.
