- I was contacted Sunday, September 20, 1981, at 4:20 p.m. by Mr. _____, a parent of a Scout in Troop 108. Mr. informed me that Mr. Eugene Huntzicker, Scoutmaster of Troop 108, had made improper advances to his sor in the form of fondling the boy's genitals and inviting the boy to fondle his genitals. Mr. further indicated that pornographic photographs and magazines involving homosexual activities had been shown to the boys. An order blank was found which indicated that Mr. Huntzicker had ordered pornographic films and literature to show to the boys in the troop.
- 2. I contacted Mr. Huntzicker's pastor, Rev. Webb, at the Aldersgate Methodist Church (sponsoring institution of Troop 108) on Tuesday, September 22, 1981 (as he was out the previous day.) Rev. Webb told me that on Friday, September 18, 1981, Mr. Huntzicker had admitted to him that the above allegations were true to some extent and that such activities had begun sometime during 1979. Mr. Huntzicker agreed to be psychoanalyzed and treated by a reputable psychiatrist. He admitted himself to a hospital in Memphis for psychoanalysis and treatment.
- 3. It was determined by the examining psychiatrist that Mr. Huntzicker is suffering from pedophilia which is caused by a state of depression and can be cured within a very short period of time. The psychiatrist indicated that this is a very common disease in adults over 40 years of age.
- 4. On Thursday, September 24, 1981, I contacted Mr. He indicated that he had visited Mr. Huntzicker and talked with him as a friend. Hr. does not feel that his son has been mentally or physically harmed and therefore does not plan to prosecute Mr. Huntzicker.
- 5. There is one parent who indicated that he might prosecute Mr. Huntzicker—although his own son was not involved in any way, other than that he was in the troop for a short period of time before the above allegations.
