

Dear Boy Scouts of America:

Conrad (Tom) Capasso was an Assistant Scoutmaster, Troop 27, St. Joseph's Church in Haverhill, Mass. from approximately October 1976 to June 1977.

During this period of time he was living in a two-family home at 64 Hancock Street in Haverhill, Mass. The other apartment was occupied by Richard E. & Gayle M. Pelland, Jr. along with their son Richard III. Richard Jr. was the Troop Committee Chairman for Froop 27. He was also District Commissioner for Whittier District. Gayle was Secretary for Troop 27 and Richard III was the Senior Patrol Leader.

Some time around February 1977, the Committee became aware of a potential problem in the Troop. Tom was accused by adult members of a Cub Scout Pack of being "Gay" and having affairs with boys in Troop 27. Members of the Committee each spoke to their own children separately and certain facts emerged. Some boys in the Troop were having problems with Tom. Even the boys that were not having problems were aware of the problems that the others were having.

Tom use to have boys in the Troop stay overnight at his house. The Pelland family was aware of this because they lived in the same house. According to the boys, indecent exposure and fondling was common. At a week-end camporee Tom was accused by a boy member of the Troop of performing an unnatural act on that boy member. Tom is alleged to have threatened all the boy members of the Troop that he was involved with. They were afraid to bring their problems out in the open.

Richard E. Pelland, Jr. as Troop Committee Chairman, advised Tom of the accusations and invited him to speak to the Committee and if unfounded, promised him the support of the Committee. Tom was also told not to show up at any troop meeting. He was asked not to speak to or have any dealing with any boy member of the Troop until the problem had been totally resolved.

Tom refused a meeting with the Troop Committee. He resigned from the Troop and moved out of Haverhill in about one month.

The Troop continued to meet on this problem. It was decided by the Troop Committee, with the support of the parents of the boys that were involved, and the Pastor of the Church that no legal action take place.

Lone Tree Council was advised of the problem from the beginning but was asked to stay out because the Committee felt it was their problem. The Committee did ask and continues to ask the Lone Tree Council and the Boy Scouts of America to be aware of these facts.

In addition to the allegations, my decision to resign is based upon a feeling of being rifted due to the following-

the troop not going on a mountain or cance trip but instead to summer camp

oral objections to the way merit badges and advancement is being taught and earned

objections to current charter registration procedures within the troop.

Dear Mr. Jarman,

We, the Committee for Troop 27, regretfully accept your resignation as a committee member. We expect that any further investigation that you may wish to conduct in the Conrad T. Capasso matter be done as an individual and not as a committee member or in any other way as a representative of Troop 27.

Please be advised that as of May 23, 1977 Mr. Conrad T. Capasso tended his resignation as both Assistant Scoutmaster and Unit Commissioner of Troop 27.

TIME I MUST RESIGN FROM MY POSITION ON THE TROOP COMMITTEE. AT THIS TIME I MUST ACT WITH MY OWN CONSCIOUS AND BE A FATHER TO MY SON AND NOT A SCOUTER. I FEEL THAT BECAUSE OF WHAT HAS SURFACED IN THE PAST WEEK, I COULD NOT BE OBJECTIVE AND IMPARTIAL AS A MEMBER OF TROOP 27. AND THEIR INVESTIGATION OF THE PROBLEM'S

()N MAY 20 1977 A PARENT OF CNE OF TRADO 27 FORMER SCOUT'S MADE SEVERAL STATEMENTS. TROOP ET IS A GAY TROOP TROOP 27 HAS A FAGGOT FOR ASSIS, SCOUTMASTER COER BOY'S ARE BULLIES AND PUSH THE YOUNGER CNES AROUND AGAINST THERE WILL, YOUR SON CANNOT BE A MAN UNLESS HE WILL SUBMIT TO BEING UNDRESSED AND WHILE SPREAD EAGLE ACROSS A PICNIC TABLE BE TORMENTED AND MARKED ABOUT THE PRIVATES. THIS IS ONLY PART OF THE UGLY THINGS THAT ARE BEING SAID OF OUR TROOP. AFTER TALKING TO THE EXEC RICK BASSET AND DICK PELLAND I MADE SEVERAL PHONE CALL'S. I WHS DISGUSTED WITH PARENT'S OPINION AND THOUGHTS CF OUR TROOP. AND LEADER S. MY SON BEING A PORTION OF THE LEADER SHIP IN THAT TROOP I DECIDED TO FIND OUT WHAT HE ENEW, HE NOT ONLY VERIFIED SEVERAL OF THE RUNIOR'S BUT REVEALED TO HLS

MOTHER AND MYSELF A JORDIO STORY OF WHAT HAS BEEN MARPENING TO HIM. HE QUIT THE TROOP SEVERAL NEEK'S AGO, BUT REALLY NEVER EXPLAIN WHY. WITH MY POSITION AND MY TEMPERHE UVED IN FEAR OF TELLING ME OR ANYONE OF HIS EXPERIENCE.

AS FATHER AND PERMISSION OF HIS
MOTHER WE INFORM YOU THAT YOUR A.S
TOM CAPASSO TROUP #27 HAS ACTED AND DID
COMMIT IMMORAL ACT'S UPON OUR SON AND
TRIED TO GET HIM TO DO THE SAME. THE GORDIO
STURY BEHIND THIS WAS IN THE GUISE OF
MERIT BADGE MEETING'S AND SUCH, AT HLS
RESIDENCE WHERE HE INVITED BOY'S TO STAY
OVERNIGHT. THE TORMENT THAT I BEAR FOR
HLS MOTHER AND SISTER'S WHO REALLY CAN'T
COMPREHEND HOW AND WHY! WHAT IS REALLY
GOING ON IN THE MIND OF MY SON BRING'S
NE TO A STATE OF ANGER THAT I CAN'T CONTROL
AT TIMES.

I FEEL THAT IF YOU CONTACT BOY'S THAT HAVE LEFT IN THE LAST EIGHT MONTH'S AND BOY'S WHO HAVE LEFTWEBELDS BUT DID NOT JOIN TROOP \$27 AND MOST OF ALL THEIR PARENTS, YOU WILL SOON SEE A LOUSY IMMAGE THAT HAS BEEN LEFT WITH ST JOSEPH SCOUTING. I HAVE CONTACTED A LAWYER AND DOWCE FOR ASSISTENCE IN BEHAL MY SON, MY MIND IS UNCLEAR AT THIS TIME HOW FAR I WILL BRING THIS TO CIGHT. I OF FEEL THAT YOUR MEETING AS COMMITTEE MEMBERS WILL HELP CORRECT THE SMALLER PROBLEMIS.

AS FOR MR CAPASSO HE SHOULD NOT BE ALLOWED TO STAY IN SCOUTING.

THIS TYPE OF PERSON NEED'S MEDICAL HELP AND THE LAW PROTECTS THEIR RIGHT TO DO WHATEVER THE GIG IS. BUT ON A YOUNG MAN WHO IS A MINOR AND CANNOT FEND OFF WHAT REALLY IS BEING TAUGHT TO HIM BY ADULT LEADER'S IS MORE THAN I CAN TAKE.

MY SON HIS MOTHER AND MYSELF WILL TESTFIE IN FRONT OF YOUR COMMITTEE OF COURSE IN PRESENSE OF OUR LAWYER, THE OUT COME OF ANY OF YOUR MEETING'S WILL BE OF INTEREST TO ME AND I WILL BE WAITING FOR A WRITTEN REPLY.
