

Sparks police have arrested all cer for reportedly enticing teenage boys to engage in sex with.

him in his apartment.

Bernard P. Doran of 555 Sullivan Lane. Sparks, was in jail today in lieu of \$60,000 bail on three counts each of sexual assault and soliciting a minor to engage in crimes against nature.

Police arrested Doran Thursday, two days after a woman and her 17-year-old son appeared at the police department to make a complaint. Police said two boys involved in the charges attend Sparks High School and the third attends Reed.

One of the boys said Doran of-41-year-old private security offi- fered them money and jewelry and quoted Doran as saving he bought another boy a motorcycle for sex. The youths said no drugs were involved, but liquor was available for them in the apartment.

> One youth said Doran told them he was a judo instructor. He said Doran would have them remove their shirts, showing them where they were vulnerable to attack. then would move his hands aroundtheir bodies.

He said he did not engage in sex with Doran, but saw Doran and another boy having sex.

We have also enclosed a copy of our March 5, 1980 letter to Mr. Doran indicating that we were waiting National's instructions following the receipt of the letter. We do hope no one there will respond directly to Mr. Doran without contacting us first.

Our attorney and we have not yet decided precisely how we will handle public relations aspects locally, nor how we will respond directly to Mr. Doran.

We have received his verbal resignation from his only remaining position with the Boy Scouts of America. In addition, we have determined that his unit registration where his fee was paid, expired effective January 31, 1980, and that the registration from which he resigned also expired since it was a multiple registration hinged upon his 1979 unit fee. We therefore have decided that it would be unnecessary to suspend his registration since none exists.



Bernard Pat Doran

- MR. OORAN HAS STATED HE SERVED A 3-YEAR SENTENCE FOR SEX OFFENSE: This is supported by Mr. Bernard P. Doran's statement as quoted from his letter, dated February 22, 1980, addressed to the Director of Scouting & Exploring Volunteer Workers. The original letter is in the possession of the National Council, Boy Scouts of America. Mr. Doran concluded the first paragraph of that letter with the following quotation: "I moved to the State of Nevada in the early part of 1977, after completing a 3-year sentence in the Rawway State Prison, for a sex offense."
- SUPPORTING STATEMENTS: Mr. Bernard P. Doran has made the same statement on separate occasions to a member of the Nevada Area Council professional staff and to a key volunteer.
- FURTHER VERIFICATION: If further verification is needed the National Council should cneck prison records at Rahway State Prison.
