
Thank you for your letter of February 17 concerning Robert Jason Branham who applied for registration as Cubmaster of Pack 83. We have placed this information in our files.

I had a conference on February 11, 1966, with Mr. of the Glen Park Elementary School, 3601 Pecos Street, Fort Worth, Texas gave full particulars of sexual deviation practiced by Robert Jason Branham in the Poly Church of Christ in 1958. It was pointed out that Mr. Branklam should not make application to come into Scouting anywhere at any time, as he would be refused.

Mr. Branham thanked us for the way in which this was being handled and indicated that he had made a mistake in the past, and the meeting which lasted about four minutes was terminated.

Mr. Branham further called me by phone within a few minutes after he had left Scout Headquarters on February 12th and asked if he could resign as Cubmaster. I told him that he should do so immediately.

Subsequently, Mr. Branham resigned as Cubmaster.

I conferred with Johnny Atkins, Fig. Director, on Monday, February 14, 1966, and acquainted him with the particulars, and also called T. C. Duncan, Neighborhood Commissioner, and Dr. J. W. Ford, Pastor of the Handley Methodist Church, and gave them the facts
