



Dear Jack:

I am enclosing photostatic copies of letters received from Clyde this morning. Following my interview with the two boys there was no question in my mind but what they were not only perfectly honest about their comments, but were not exaggerating for effect.

You have a copy of my letter to Glyde, and with this reply you should encourage your troop committee to accept his resignation without further fanfare. While he should be encouraged to have no further contact at troop meetings, outings, etc., I can see no reason why he shouldn't be recognized at the 50th anniversary celebration if you and the committee see fit. Of course he may not want to participate, but from his point of view it would help to allay questions about his retirement from the troop. I am sure there are key members of the troop committee that need to know the story, but the less it is discussed among adults and boys I am sure the better it will be.

Dear Clyde:

There are times when my job as Scout executive of this council brings responsibilities that are most painful indeed. I have in my possession two statements from boy members of your Troop 220 charging you with relationships with them as well as other members of the troop over the past few years that cannot be condoned by the Boy Scouts of America.

I have been informed by a member of the troop committee with whom I have discussed the situation that you have been called to task at least twice previously for unseeming conduct in taking pictures of your Scouts in the nude and exhibiting around your home where Scouts have been invited these pictures plus others of both nude men and women. While in the judgment of Scouting's leadership this type of activity cannot be condoned, the charges made are far more serious.

Clyde, at this moment two boys and a member of the troop committee know of this situation. I have one of two alternatives: Ask the troop committee to accept your resignation from the troop and the Scouting program immediately; or two, if you choose to fight the charges we will then have to investigate the situation more deeply, requesting statements from at least ten additional boys whose names have been included, as well as parents and other members of the committee.

Please understand one thing—the Boy Scouts of America makes no charge against you whatsoever. It simply will exercise the right which for 58 years it has always retained, that of withholding an adult commission. I will discuss the matter with you in person if you so wish, or I will instruct the troop committee to accept your resignation. Am sorry that your activities have resulted in charges that I cannot ignore.
