Mr. Dailey is currently registered as a Deighborhood Commissioner, RFD #4, New Milford, Conn., 06776. He is an American citizen, 21 years of age and is multi-registered as committeeman for Troop 26.

Mr. Dailey was picked up by the local police recently on a morals charge and was sentenced last week to either 2 years in a reformatory or to be submitted to the state mental institution. He has chosen the latter course. Due to the seriousness of his crime, he was lucky to get aff with this light sentence because had he been brought before a Bridgeport, Conn. judge who had tried him on a similar charge two years ago, he would have gotten a much more severe punishment we were unaware of his previous charge, however we were informed that he had been seeing a psychiatrist but was under control of himself and there was no reason why he should not carry on a normal life. I would like to add that as far as we know, all of Mr. Dailey's activities were outside of Scouting circles and therefore brought no disgrace to the Boy Scouts, other than his being currently registered.
