



- 2. When an adult changes position within a unit or council.
- 3. When a Boy Scout or Explorer reaches 18 years of age

and registers as an associate Advisor.

4. When a member dies (please include his last address). When a boy or an adult pays a registration fee, he is entitled to membership until the expiration date indicated on his membership certificate.

Separation notices must not be sent to the national office at the time of reregistration or for unreregistered units.

For a boy transferring to a new unit, submit an additional enrollment to add him to this new unit. This separation notice only separates him from his previous unit, it does not add him to his new unit.
